C1 - PRIX DES BENEVOLES - 2675m (a1m1/2) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 20,000

- LOLA DU CAMPUS Always gives her best but will need to show marked improvement on last month's 5th of 8 in a 2950m Saint-Malo Class F
- 2. LADY FLO DE MAX Opened her account in a 2850m Class F at Bagnoles-de-l'Orne mid-August, first time with Franck Nivard reining. Sébastien Ernault at the helm this time but the step up in category may be a step too far
- **3. LILI DE POMMERAYE** Disappointing this year, latterly last but one in a 2750m Cabourg Class D on 20 August, and has no possible chance
- **4. LIKE A PRAYER -** Opened her account at Rochefort-sur-Loire in July before running 2nd of 8 in a 2600m Class F at Le Touquet 3 weeks ago. Takes on some better horses here but sports pads for first time and represents a respectable first-5 prospect
- **5. LILIBET -** Put a brace of sanctions behind her when winning a 2500m Vibraye Class F 2 weeks ago but faces a much stiffer test this time around
- **6. LYRE D'ERABLE -** Lost her maiden status at Bréhal on 12 August before coming 2nd of 14 in a 2800m Bernay Class E a fortnight ago. A repeat, at this level however, seems improbable
- **7. LIANGA** Barring one sanction, has been hard to fault for past 3 months, latterly 3rd behind LETTRE D'ERABLE (13) in a 2800m Bernay Class E a fortnight ago, and is unlikely to be far from the action
- **8. LAMTARA BUISSONAY -** Unexceptional sort that finished 7th of 10, behind L'AMETHYSTE (9), on first start back, in a 2050m Cabourg Class E late last month, and appears to need another outing
- **9. L'AMETHYSTE** Made up for her previous performance when 3rd of 10 in a 2050m Cabourg Class E late last month. Should take well to the new conditions and has a realistic chance of finishing close
- **10. LADY EVER -** Showed the limit of her capacity when last but one in a 2875m Enghien Class E a month ago but, in this company, has a reasonable chance of finishing in the thick of things
- **11. LAYANA DE HOUELLE -** Complemented her Redon success with 3rd of 7 in a 2725m Pornichet Class E 10 days ago and appears to have the measure of most here. Claim
- **12. LORELEI -** 4th of 7 in a 2750m Cabourg Class D on 20 August. Has demonstrated decent versatility and drops marginally in category with a good hand to play
- **13. LETTRE D'ERABLE -** Well-beaten 4th of 6, on first start since the spell, in a 2700m Graignes Class B a month back. Will have come on for the run but still seems to have too much to do
- **14. LITTLE DU RIB -** Close 2nd in a 2625m Cherbourg Class E 3 weeks ago. Enjoys a terrific entry and will have a realistic chance of winning this if she turns

Summary: Solid as a rock since returning to competition, LAYANA DE HOUELLE (11) proved herself right-handed at Redon and, with Mathieu Mottier reining this time, can repeat. Runner-up in her last two, LITTLE DU RIB (14) still has to prove herself racing clockwise but in current form looks a serious proposition. LORELEI (12) has come close more than once to getting off the mark and can make a big splash. Encouraging last time out, L'AMETHYSTE (9) is not going to be far from the action.

- **1. KENTUCKY RUSH -** Tries his hand in the monté discipline after faulting in a 2650m Vertou Class H a fortnight ago, and is clearly out of his league
- **2. KIOSQUE -** Has shown no aptitude for either code, latterly sanctioned in a 2700m Graignes Class F a month back, and has no realistic chance
- **3. KRISTINA DU CLOS -** Twice 5th under the saddle before finishing 9th of 13 in a 2800m Vire harness Class E on Wednesday. Barefoot for the occasion but a minor place chance at best
- **4. KAKOU ALDO -** Quality sort that made up for his Vire blip with an authoritative win in a Class E over course and distance on 18 August, and has a realistic chance of confirming
- **5. KINA DU GOUTIER -** Takes her chances in the monté code for first time, having finished 10th of 13 in a 2750m Cabourg Class E 12 days ago, and even with hind shoes off, can expect to have few takers
- **6. KALIMERA FLASH -** Switches code for first time after coming 6th of 7 in a 2950m Saint-Malo Class E on 13 August, but is not devoid of ability and should not be overlooked
- **7. KATKO DES CAILLONS -** Ran 2nd of 11 in a 2750m Cabourg Class F on return to the code mid-August. Has never disappointed under the saddle and must be respected
- **8. KALOU DES NOEES -** 3rd on monté debut here on 18 July before repeating in a 2750m Cabourg Class E later that month, and looks capable of trotting his way into the frame
- **9. KEOPS DE GODINIERE -** 2nd of 8 in a 2550m Cherbourg Class E 3 weeks ago. Has solid right-handed references and, with form and stride maintained, will be in a position to give this a good go
- **10. KOBANA DU CYGNE -** Sanctioned in a 3025m Montier-en-Der harness Class F 3 weeks ago. Is nowhere near her best and must get her house in order
- **11. KANA DE SUCE -** Put 5 straight sanctions behind her when victorious in a 2850m Mauquenchy Class F on 5 August. Is as complicated as they come but on good behaviour can play a prominent role
- **12. KUZA DU BOUILLON -** Absolutely flying when sanctioned in a 2725m Pornichet Class E on 8 August. Has been afforded time to freshen up and, if focused, can make a big impact

Summary: With the exception of his Vire sanction, KAKOU ALDO (4) has been remarkable in the monté code and, given the nature of his victory here last month, he will again take all the beating. That said, KUZA DU BOUILLON (12) could well have won at Pornichet a month ago had she stayed in stride, and must be afforded due credit. Clear 3rd here mid-July, KALOU DES NOEES (8) ran 3rd of 10 in a 2750m Cabourg Class E a fortnight later and, fresh for the occasion, is not about to let the side down. 3rd at Graignes before coming 2nd at Cherbourg 3 weeks ago, KEOPS DE GODINIERE (9) will be expected to challenge for a podium-place once more.

- 1. JOBIC KERGWEN Pleasant in 2 before being sanctioned in a 2600m Landivisiau Class F last Sunday and others easier to trust
- 2. JADE SOTHO Last but one in a 2650m Vertou Class F a fortnight ago. Would be preferred at a lower level however
- **3. JACINTHE DES BOIS -** Sanctioned in 2 after winning at Châteaubriant a month ago, most recently a 2850m Laval Class F 9 days ago. Is confirmed here though and, with application, can finish in the mix
- **4. JACK HERER -** 6th of 10 in a 2625m Class F at Saint-Jean-de-Monts on 11 August. Has been off the boil since the spring and chances limited
- **5. JELGA DU VIVIER -** Sanctioned in 2 before coming 4th of 14 in a 2650m Alençon Class F last weekend. Faulted on only appearance at the venue and is not about to generate much interest
- **6. JOYEUX DE BOLERO -** 3rd in a Châteaubriant Class F before coming 5th of 8 in a 2725m Cabourg Class E on 20 August and, in this category, can play a leading role
- **7. JABOROSA BLUE -** Reassuring 4th of 12 in a 2725m Cabourg claimer on 20 August but, in this company, has no possible chance
- **8. JOS DU PILET -** Returned to winning ways last Sunday, landing a 2550m Class F at Gournay-en-Bray. Shod similarly, with same driver at the helm, and although not a priority, is still worth monitoring

Nathanaël Picard will be justifiably wary of JOYEUX DE BOLERO (6) who drops back in class following a pair of encouraging efforts, and JANETTE TY (12) who is enjoying something of a resurgence. Plainly in good condition, and barefoot for the occasion, JAMAICA D'OYSE (10) is most certainly one for the shortlist.

- **2. KEILA DU PERCHE** Missed out by little for second in a 2050m Cabourg Class D 2.5 weeks ago and can figure prominently if she takes to the new profile
- **3. KASTA DU RIB -** Somewhat unlucky to fault in a 2725m Cabourg Class E mid-August. Returns to the venue of his last success though and, with application, can impose
- **4. KISS ME DE BELFOND** 6th of 7 in an incident-filled 2600m Landivisiau Class E last Sunday and can be confidently disregarded
- 5. KASPAROVA Left a very good impression late last month when 4th of 12 in a 2750m Cabourg Class F and will not be available at 45/1 this time around
- **6. KUTARA MICHE** Made amends for being pulled-up at Cabourg when 2nd of 12 in a 2300m Châteaubriant Class E on 9 August and, if still on the boil, can play a leading role
- **7. KATANA** Encouraging 5th of 9 in a 2725m Cabourg Class E on 16 August, but a repeat performance seems most improbable

Summary: A winner over course and distance mid-July, KASTA DU RIB (3) was not the most fortunate under difficult conditions last time out but has the capacity to put things right and win this. She will still face resistance from KUTARA MICHE (6) who reassured at Châteaubriant a month ago, and KEILA DU PERCHE (2) who has been knocking at the door recently. KASPAROVA (5) has been acquitting herself well of late and her recent Cabourg performance augurs well for her chances.

- **4. FIRST DES BORDES -** 2nd of 10 in a 3200m Landivisiau amateurs Class H last Sunday. Not as sharp as he once was and others preferred
- **5. ISSU DE CORTEM -** Back under harness after running 2nd of 11 in a 2550m Les Andelys monté Class F late last month. Has no right-handed references but he nevertheless deserves to take his chances
- **6. FRANKLIN STAR -** Returns to the professional ranks after trotting 4th of 12 in a 2525m Class F at Les Andelys late last month, but appears to be biting off more than he can chew

- **3. GET UP BROWN -** 7th of 9 in a 2775m Craon Class D last Monday. Has been disappointing this summer and, hind shoes off or not, can be ruled out
- **4. ELDER SHADOW -** Surprising 6th of 9, at 114/1, behind GO FOR BELLAY (2) in a 2750m Cabourg Class E on 23 August. Little chance of imposing but a place in the frame is well within his reach
- **5. HAUTENTICA -** Seldom returns from a monté mission empty-handed, most recently winning a 2875m Enghien Class F mid-August and, with Paul Ploquin back in the irons, can double up
- **6. HAMISH -** 7th behind GO FOR BELLAY (2) in Cabourg race of reference. Is in his category and could well trot his way onto the podium
- **7. HILTON MAZA -** Would have finished 4th in a 2725m Lisieux Class F 3 months ago had he stayed trotting. Reverts to a previous configuration for comeback and not an obvious choice
- **8. GAINFUL DELO -** 10th of 13 in a 2650m Alençon harness Class D last weekend. Unseen under the saddle since August 2022, but could still pick up some crumbs in this modest field

Summary: Courageous winner at Enghien mid-August, HAUTENTICA (5) comes to Le Mont-Saint-Michel with decent harness form at the venue and, barefoot again, should not disappoint. Paul Ploquin can still expect to encounter opposition from GO FOR BELLAY (2) who showed marked improvement at Cabourg recently, and ELDER SHADOW (4) who finished 2 places behind him that day.
