- **1. IT'S ALL A DREAM -** Won a 1600m PSF conditions race at Pau in January but finished unplaced in 9 subsequent appearances, the latest (9th) over 1300m in a Craon handicap on 23 September
- **2. CALCUTTA CUP -** Fluffed his lines when finishing 10th in a 1900m PSF handicap at Chantilly on 7 September but has the means to redeem himself, having finished 2nd at Deauville in his previous outing. Not without a chance
- **3. FILLE DU ROI** Inconsistent filly unplaced in 11 consecutive appearances, the latest (8th) in a 1400m handicap at Compiegne on 25 September
- **4. LEX LUTHOR** Consistent veteran handicapper with sound references/form credentials in handicaps at this level, including a last-start 6th in a 1400m handicap at Strasbourg on 15 September
- **5. PORTRERO -** Ultra-consistent handicapper, though rarely wins (has 2 victories from 34 starts). Has maintained a good level of form and consistency, and confirmed as much by finishing 4th over track and trip on 19 September

Summary: PORTRERO (5), after an encouraging 4th last time out, is a serious candidate for success, though the same could be said of the 5th finisher that day DORIANELLO (8), who again enjoys the benefit of Pierre Remoué's weight allowance. BEST SIXTEEN (9), who also ran in that race, is well positioned in the stalls and has the means to make his presence felt too. GALALITHE (7) makes most appeal of the remainder.

- **2. AMOUAGE -** Won a 1400m Clairefontaine-Deauville handicap on 28 June but finished unplaced (soundly beaten) in all 4 of his subsequent appearances, the latest (9th) in a 1400m Strasbourg handicap on 15 September
- **3. LE FRIOLIN -** Gianluca Bietolini-trained Galiway gelding to be ridden on debut by Aude Duporté, who has a 1,5kg allowance
- **4. RAIKE -** Unplaced (6th) in a 1900m PSF claimer at Deauville on 17 August. Could do better reverting to turf

- 2. EVER READY Inconsistent colt with sufficient means to acquit himself competitively in a race of this ilk off his current mark. Didn't go unnoticed when 6th in a course-and-distance handicap on 19 September
- 3. PRINCEDESCHAMPS Caught the eye with a fast-finishing 3rd in a course-and-distance handicap in 19 September. Failed to confirm that form/improvement when only 9th over 2200m at Amiens last time but shouldn't be hastily condemned
- **4. FAZZANO -** Inconsistent German performer sporting headgear for the first time on French soil off a career-low mark. Could do better than his last-start 8th in over 2100m at Mülheim on 17 August

- **3. GIORGIANA** Didn't go unnoticed when 7th in a course-and-distance claimer on 19 September so shouldn't be taken lightly, having dropped slightly in the weights/ratings. Dark horse
- **4. CLAIM THE STARS -** Ideally suited to this distance, over which he won a handicap at Chantilly 3 starts back (3 September) and 3rd in his latest appearance at that venue on 3 October. Has a winning chance in his first outing on this course

- **3. BLACK HAWK** Continues to blow hot and cold but retains the means to be competitive at this level, having finished 3rd in a 3100m Saint-Cloud handicap last month. Not hastily condemned for his 8th at Craon on 23 September

- **3. SKY GOLD -** Last-start winner over the course and distance in his first appearance in the claiming category (19 September). Candidate for success
- **4. STRANGELOVE -** Unplaced in all 4 appearances, though wasnt entirely disgraced when 5th over course and distance in a similar contest on 19 September. Improvement needed
- **5. MAITRE DE CHANT -** Lightly raced 3-year-old who has revealed sufficient means in conditions/maiden races to be competitive in a race of this nature. Didn't go unnoticed when 5th over 2400m at Lyon-Parilly on 17 September

- **3. DAPANGO -** Won a claimer over 1800m at Dieppe in his first outing on French soil and backed that up with a good 2nd over 1600m in a claiming race at Fontainebleau on 22 September. Keep safe
- **4. RIDPOUR -** Caught the eye with a reassuring 2nd over 1600m in a conditions race at Vichy on 14 August. Will play a leading role if confirming that improvement

Summary: MILLEBOSC (5) is no longer the force of old but showed he retains zest for racing by winning at La-Roche-Posay last time, and he's good value to follow up at the primary expense of RIDPOUR (4) who made an encouraging reappearance at Vichy. MY FANCY (1) is another with legitimate ambitions after missing last Tuesday's Quinte+. DAPANGO (3) appeals most of the remainder.
