- **1. JABIRU BOY -** Lightly raced, prolific gelding with 5 victories from his 7 completed races (9 starts). Has won 3 of his 4 outings in this shoe-fitting, including consecutive recent outings the latest over 2950m at Saint-Malo on 12 July
- **2. JOB DU CEBE -** Rewarded for consistency with a last-start victory at Chinon (on turf) over 3100m on 14 July. Ought to remain competitive
- **3. JADE -** Hard-knocker confirmed in this shoe-fitting and seldom far off the mark. Didn't go unnoticed when 6th over course and distance on 21 July

4. JOSIO DU POMMEREUX -

- **5. JERICHO DU RIB -** Shouldn't be hastily condemned for his last-start failure (disqualification) over 2750m at Cabourg on 12 July, having achieved his best references (all 4 career wins) on a right-hand track. Cannot be underestimated
- **6. JIPEBE -** Most effective under the saddle achieved his best references (all 3 wins) in the mounted code when unshod so is best watched for now. Last seen finishing 4th at Pornichet in a 2725m mounted race on 6 July
- **7. JILBOUR DEFONTAINE** Delicate but has undeniable means/ability usually acquits himself well when avoiding disqualification, and confirmed as much by finishing 2nd in this shoe-fitting at Durtal over 2825m on 14 July. All or nothing
- **8. JOKER DU PONT -** Has lost his way/form this year disqualified in 3 consecutive starts, the latest in a mounted race over 2475m at Francheville on 14 July. Others preferred
- **9. JAPPELOU -** Won a 2675m harness race at Lisieux in May but has gone off the boil since unplaced (9th) next time out and disqualified in consecutive recent starts, the latest over this track and trip on 21 July
- **10. JACK DU PONT -** Ultra-consistent, reliable trotter (never disqualified in his 21 appearances) who finished 2nd in his only outing on this Meslay-du-Maine track. Didn't go unnoticed when 5th over 3025m at Luçon on 21 July
- **11. JUNKIES MINDS -** Revealed considerable early promise, winning 5 of first 6 completed races (8 starts). Has regained momentum after a last-start 5th (shod) at Cabourg over 2750m on 23 July and is ideally engaged with all 4 shoes removed

Summary: JABIRU BOY (1) has won 3 of his last 4 starts (all in this shoe-fitting) and remains open to further progress in just his 10th outing. With that improvement on the cards, he gets the nod ahead of JUNKIES MINDS (11) who should have more to offer racing in this (barefoot) configuration for the first time in his career. JERICHO DU RIB (5), despite a recent faux pas (disqualification), is capable of making his presence felt too. JACK DU PONT (10), JOB DU CEBE (2) and JILBOUR DEFONTAINE (7) complete the shortlist.

- 2. KURAPIKA DU PONT Capable but has gone off the boil recently disqualified in consecutive recent outings, the latest over 2950m at Biarritz on 20 July. Improvement needed
- **3. KITTY -** Complicated filly but is undeniably talented hasn't finished worse than 3rd in her 6 completed races (9 starts), winning twice and finishing 2nd three times. Runner-up in consecutive recent outings, the latest over 2775m at Les Sables-d'Olonne on 10 July
- **4. KASSIOPEIA -** Has only once finished out of the first four in nine appearances (10 starts), winning once and finishing 2nd four times including consecutive recent outings earlier this month, the latest at Clairefontaine (2900m) on 20 July
- **5. KAKUETA VEDAQUAISE -** Consistent filly with sound references, including a creditable 5th at odds of 94/1 over 2875m at this venue on 30 May. Not disgraced in either subsequent outing (finished 7th in both), the latest at Enghien on 6 July
- **6. KARAIELLA BOND -** Complicated filly with sufficient means to make her presence felt, even with her irons fitted (shod), judged on her best references. Needs to reaffirm after back-to-back disqualifications, the latest at Les Sables on 13 July
- **7. KAZAN DE VANDEL** Ideally entered on the front row (just €75 from the limit of decline) and has regained momentum recently with 2 pleasing comeback outings. Showed his form and well-being by finishing 2nd (barefoot) at Cabourg on 9 July

Summary: KAZAN DE VANDEL (7) finished 2nd in this (barefoot) configuration over 2725m at Cabourg earlier in the month (9 July) and has a lot in his favour here, with Eric Raffin at the helm from a front-line starting berth. He is, therefore, preferred to KITTY (3) who also benefits from a first-post departure point, so should fight for victory. KARAMBAR (11), despite conceding a 25m headstart to that pair, has the means to make up the ground and stake a claim in the outcome. KEVISAN (9), KANELLE DE TILLARD (8), KASSIOPEIA (4) and KARAIELLA BOND (6) have place prospects.

- **3. HELIUM DE L'ITON -** Complicated but is confirmed under these conditions/in this (plated) shoe-fitting and has been in good form of late, confirmed as much with an encouraging 3rd over 2750m at Cabourg on 9 July. Attractive outsider
- **4. STARO MOJITO -** Well-performed veteran who showed his versatility/efficiency under the saddle with an encouraging 2nd on his debut in the mounted category over 2950m at Vichy on 4 July. Will be a factor

- **7. FALKIR BUIZARDERIE** Has regained momentum recently and boasts sound references/form credentials in the mounted category. Didn't go unnoticed when 5th under the saddle over 2950m at Vichy on 26 June
- **8. HOLKA DU LYS -** Delicate but, judged on her best references (achieved at a higher level) is undeniably capable of fighting for the victory. Shouldn't be hastily condemned for her last-start disqualification at Montier-en-Der on 7 July

Summary: GOUTIER CELESTE (5) has won his last three starts under the saddle and done so easily on each occasion, so he is hard to oppose. Versatile STARO MOJITO (4) showed his efficiency/competitiveness under the saddle when 2nd in a mounted race 2 starts back on 4 July at Vichy. He is taken to win the race to fill the runners-up berth ahead of HOLKA DU LYS (8) and IDOLA PHEDO (2), who have already proven themselves under the saddle.

- 2. JONCTION HAUFOR Disqualified in 8 of her last 10 starts, including 4 consecutive recent outings racing unshod the latest (19 July) over 2725m at Pornichet. Sports this shoe-fitting for the first time in her career
- **3. JADORE GIRL -** Delicate mare seldom far from a fault. Halted a series of 4 consecutive disqualifications with a last-start victory over 2950m at Saint-Malo with Eric Raffin in the sulky confirmation expected with the duo reunited here
- **4. JASMINE DU MAXFRAN** Made no impression on her return from a 7-month absence over 3100m at Chinon on 14 July. Others preferred
- **5. JOHANNA JOBYNA -** Disqualified in 6 of his last 8 appearances, including his latest at Argentan on 15 July. Rarely finishes far off the mark when avoiding disqualification
- **6. JOSY EXPRESS -** Capable, lightly raced mare but has achieved her best performances/references racing unshod. Disqualified on her reappearance after a 6-month layoff over 2850m at Laval on 3 July for another day

JITANA WILD (9), JADE FOR EVER (7) and JADE DE TOUCHYVON (8) have legitimate ambitions for a podium finish.

- 3. LIBREVILLE FLIGNY Placed (3rd) on debut but has failed to confirm that promise in 6 subsequent unplaced appearances, the latest (6th) at Vichy over 2950m on 2 July
- **4. LOLA DU CAMPUS -** Has acquitted herself consistently/competitively in her last 3 appearances, the latest (4th) over 2550m at Reims on 2 June. Outsider
- **5. LOUMIA DE LA LEUE -** Consistent, honest performer who hasn't been far off the mark in all 4 appearances finished 3rd twice and 5th in her last start over 2725m at Pornichet on 4 July. Outsider

- **4. HULTIMA -** Has been off the boil (lost her way/form) for some time now and was disqualified in her last start over 2900m at Clairefontaine on 20 July
- **5. FURY D'EVEL -** Consistent performer at this level and confirmed under these conditions, even with his irons (shod). Didn't go unnoticed when 5th over track and trip on 21 July
- **6. GOOD COMPUTER -** Inconsistent veteran but has is confirmed under these conditions/in this shoe-fitting. Not taken lightly after an encouraging last-start 5th over 2600m at Genêts on 21 July
- **7. ENGOULVENT DU LYS -** Soundly beaten (unplaced) in each comeback appearance this year, the latest at Chinon over 3100m on 14 July
- **8. HENJOY DE MONGOCHY -** Rarely far from a fault but, judged on his best references (including a victory at this level), is certainly capable of winning a race like this. A question of wisdom with him all or nothing (disqualified at Argentan on 15 July)

Summary: Last-start winner HAPPY HERO (3) boasts sound references in the amateur category and appeals most judged on the strength and consistency of his recent form. HENJOY DE MONGOCHY (8) is capable of great things when avoiding disqualification and is likely to pose a threat if applied/remaining wise throughout. HUNIQUE (1) is a model of consistency and could join that fight for victory. FURY D'EVEL (5) appeals most of the remainder.
