

TUESDAY, 25/06/24

C1 - PRIX FRANCE GALOP - 1100m (a5f1/2) - TURF - Class 4 Handicap - Flat - EUR € 18,000

1. TILL WE DIE - Much improved of late and was a winner of a handicap over this course and distance last time out on 2 May. Carries a 3kg penalty for that win but can follow up

2. DON FALCO - Better on the PSF and was tenth last time out in a Conditions race at Marseille-Borély over 1200m on 27 May. Others are preferred

3. EXCALIBUR - Disappointing form of late and was 7th last time out in a handicap at Dieppe over this distance on 14 June. Needs to find a few lengths to win

4. EXPERTISE - Unreliable this year and was 6th last time out in a Conditions race at Marseille-Borély over 1200m on 27 May. Others are preferred

5. WASACHOP - Unreliable but did show his best when winning a handicap last time out at Marseille-Borély over 1200m on 7 June. Carries a 2,50kg penalty for that win but deserves respect

6. BIJLEE - Ultra-consistent of late and was a winner of a handicap at Lyon-Parilly over 1350m on 1 June. Carries a 2kg penalty for that win but will be a threat

7. LUDDEN LASS - Yet to win a race and was 7th last time out in a handicap at Marseille-Vivieux over 1500m on 24 May. Has run well over this track and trip and is not out of it

8. VANILLE BLEUE - Unreliable and was 8th last time out in a handicap at Marseille-Borély over 1200m on 7 June. Did better at this course before that and has a place chance

9. TALLINSKI - Knocking hard at the door and was a runner-up last time out in a handicap at Dieppe over this distance on 14 June. Be right there at the finish once again

Summary: A competitive start to the card. TILL WE DIE (1) will carry a penalty for a good in over this course and distance last time out and may well follow up. BIJLEE (6) is very consistent and will not go down without a good fight. TALLINSKI (9) is knocking very hard at the door but may have to settle for a place again. LUDDEN LASS (7) has run well at this course before and is not out of it

**C2 - PRIX DES BENEVOLES - 1100m (a5f1/2) - TURF - Claiming - Flat -
EUR € 12,500**

1. CLOSE COMBAT - Has done best in claimers and was 7th last time out in a Conditions race at Marseille-Borély over 1200m on 14 June. Capable of bouncing back to score

2. LES MARQUISES - Disappointing last run when 7th in a claimer at Marseille-Borély over 1200m on 3 May. Place chance in this line-up

3. WASIVALCHOPE - Modest debut when 8th in a Conditions race at Lyon-Parilly over 1350m on 1 June. Likely to improve dropped to a claimer and has a winning chance

4. QUEEN'S CITY - Showed some improvement when third last time out in a claimer at Lyon-Parilly over 1350m on 8 June. Can contest the finish again

5. TREVI - Disappointing last run and was 7th last time out in a claimer at Evreux over 1200m on 22 May. Might play a minor role

6. EXPLOSIVE ACTION - Has not shown much in three claimers and was 9th last time out at Argentan over 1300m on 5 June. Can improve and earn some minor money

7. NACRE FONTANEL - Finished 5th in her second start which was in a claimer at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 1000m on 20 June. More is needed to beat these rivals

8. EVERBLOOM - Finished 7th last time out in a claimer at Angers over 1350m on 20 June. Did better in her penultimate start but others are preferred

Summary: CLOSE COMBAT (1) has good form in this division and has a big winning chance in this line-up. WASIVALCHOPE (3) did not run badly on debut and could make vast improvement trying a claimer this time. QUEEN'S CITY (4) showed some improvement last time out and deserves some respect. EXPLOSIVE ACTION (6) is capable of improvement with Blinkers on this time.

C3 - PRIX DU CONSEIL DU GALOP SUD-EST - 2400m (a1m1/2) - TURF - Handicap - Flat - EUR € 20,000

- 1. EL KALBITO** - Unreliable and was 5th last time out in a handicap at Dax over 2100m on 10 June. Needs to do a bit more to win this race
- 2. IL CAPO** - Yet to win but he is in good shape and was third last time out in a handicap at Marseille-Borély over 2600m on 7 June. Big chance in this line-up
- 3. LAZULITE** - Distance suited and has been good in claimers of late, winning last time out at Lyon-Parilly over this distance on 8 June. Not out of it
- 4. LEGEND RACE** - Showed what he is capable of when winning last time out in a Conditions race at Lyon-Parilly over this distance on 18 May. Could be the surprise package of the race
- 5. MEASTER OWEN** - Improving and was a winner last time out of a Conditions race at ParisLongchamp over 2000m on 3 May. Likes the grass and should fight out the finish
- 6. HOPEFULLY** - Yet to win a race and was 5th last time out in a claimer at Dax over 2300m on 10 June. Others are preferred
- 7. JIL IS LUCKY** - Showed some improvement when runner-up last time out in a claimer at Marseille-Borély over 2100m on 7 June. Might play a minor role
- 8. NEVER LEAVE** - Holding form well and was a runner-up last time out in a Conditions race at Montauban over 2250m on 19 May. Place chance
- 9. L'HORLOGE** - In good form and was not disgraced when 5th last time out in a handicap at Marseille-Borély over 2600m on 7 June. Should contest the finish this distance
- 10. I HAVE THE TOUCH** - Heavily raced this year and was fourth last time out in a Conditions race at Châtillon-sur-Chalonne over 2600m on 20 May. Could play a minor role

Summary: IL CAPO (2) is in good form and is a confident picky to get a deserved first victory. MEASTER OWEN (5) likes the grass and is improving so should fight out the finish. LAZULITE (3) was a very easy winner of a claimer last time out and can contest the finish. L'HORLOGE (9) is in good form and looks suited to this distance. She is capable of making the frame

C4 - PRIX FRANCOIS BLANC - 2400m (a1m1/2) - TURF - Class 3 Handicap - Flat - EUR € 20,000

- 1. KAYRAT** - He has already won four times this year and was fourth last time out in a Conditions race at Marseille-Borély over 2600m on 7 June. Should contest the finish
- 2. MONACO RULES** - Disappointing last run when 11th in a handicap at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2400m on 16 May. Could make the frame
- 3. PORTALIS** - Unreliable and was well beaten last time out in a handicap at Marseille-Borély over 2000m on 27 May. Capable of earning some money
- 4. DIANE'S STAR** - Unreliable and was 11th last time out in a handicap at Strasbourg over 3000m on 29 May. Has won over this track and trip and is not out of it
- 5. WILLY WINNER** - Has already won twice this year and was 7th last time out in a handicap at Lyon-Parilly over this distance on 8 June. Ran well at this track before that and is not out of it
- 6. PICNIC ROYAL** - In fair form of late and was 5th last time out in a claimer at ParisLongchamp over 2000m on 13 June. Might play a minor role
- 7. L'INDOMPTABLE** - In very good shape and was third last time out in a Claimer at Compiègne over 2000m on 31 May. She has won her last two handicaps and can score again
- 8. ARCUBIATU** - Did not show his best when 9th last time out in a handicap at Marseille-Borély over 1700m on 7 June. Tries further and could be the surprise package of the race
- 9. MOZART DES BRIERES** - Disappointing last run when tenth in a handicap at Strasbourg over 3000m on 8 May. Consistent before that and could earn some money
- 10. AIXELLENCE** - Unreliable this year and was tenth last time out in a handicap at Marseille-Borély over 2000m on 27 May. Others are preferred
- 11. JARDIN BLEU** - Unreliable and was 7th last time out in a Conditions race at Saint-Cloud over this distance on 10 May. Won his last handicap and deserves respect for that win
- 12. MOUTRAKI** - In good form of late and was fourth last time out in a handicap at Marseille-Borély over 2600m on 14 June. Can contest the finish again

Summary: L'INDOMPTABLE (7) is in very good shape and picked up her last two handicaps. She will be right there at the finish once again. WILLY WINNER (5) did not show his best last time out but has won twice this year and is not out of it. KAYRAT (1) likes this track and has been good this year winning four times so deserves respect. MOUTRAKI (12) is also in good form and we can expect an exciting finish

**C5 - PRIX LAURENT BRUNA - 2400m (a1m1/2) - TURF - Claiming - Flat -
EUR € 15,000**

1. KING ZARAK - In very good form and was a winner last time out in a handicap at Marseille-Borély over 2600m on 7 June. Finished third in this class before that and can bounce back to score

2. TERRE BLANCHE - Holding her form and was fourth last time out in a claimer at Marseille-Borély over 2100m on 7 June. Better this distance and has a place chance

3. GOLDEN FLASH - Only fair in two starts and was 5th last time out in a Conditions race over this track and trip on 20 May. Can do even better this time

4. URBAN TERRITORY - Very consistent in Spain this year and was third last time out over this distance at Madrid on 2 June. Can contest the finish again

5. TRUE BOY - Improving and was victorious last time out in a Conditions race at Royan La Palmyre over 2900m on 2 June. Tries a claimer and could follow up

6. SPEEDY RECORD - Broke a long losing run when scoring a claimer at Dax over 2300m on 10 June. More is needed to beat these rivals

7. NORTH RAIN - Won on debut over this distance but did not repeat that last time out when tenth in a conditions race at Strasbourg over 2000m on 13 June. Could improve dropped to a claimer

8. MIDDLE KICK - Unreliable but did win a Conditions race at Marseille-Vivaux last time out over 2000m on 24 May. Can double up if in the same mood

Summary: KING ZARAK (1) is in good form and is capable of bouncing back to score. URBAN TERRITORY (4) was very consistent in Spain and was fourth last time in a better race than this so is a surprise entry for a claimer. TRUE BOY (5) is improving and was a good winner last time out. GOLDEN FLASH (3) has some fair and could improve in this division but takes on some better than average claimers

C6 - PRIX RADIO MARITIMA - 1800m (a1m1/8) - TURF - Class 4 Claiming - Flat - EUR € 16,000

1. **EDITED** - Better on the PSF and was 11th last time out in a handicap at Marseille-Borély over 1700m on 7 June. Others are preferred

2. **BAKHCHISARAY** - Has struggled of late and was tenth last time out in a handicap at Marseille-Borély over 2000m on 27 May. Has won a claimer before and is not out of it

3. **KAPETANIOS** - Not disgraced when third last time out in a handicap at Marseille-Borély over 2000m on 27 May. Does well in claimers and has a winning chance

4. **SPIRIT GREY** - Both wins were on the PSF and was 6th last time out in a Conditions hurdle at Dax over 3500m on 2 June. Others are preferred

5. **IZASTEP** - Disappointing of late and was well beaten last time out in a handicap at ParisLongchamp over 1400m on 28 April. Capable of winning in this division

6. **VERITABLE** - Did not show his best form when tenth in a handicap last time out at ParisLongchamp over 2000m on 5 May. Can contest the finish dropped to a claimer

7. **BLANC BLEU** - Did not show his best when tenth last time out in a handicap at Marseille-Borély over 2000m on 27 May. In good form before that and has a place chance

8. **MAMA IMELDA** - May have needed her only run of this year when 7th last time out in a handicap at Marseille-Borély over 1700m on 10 May. Fitter this time and could make the frame

9. **MUELHEIMER PERLE** - Heavily raced this year and was well beaten last time out in a handicap at Marseille-Borély over 2000m on 27 May. Has run well in this division before and has a winning chance

Summary: Jérôme Reynier has a decent hand in this race with IZASTEP (5) and VERITABLE (6). Both are dropped to this division for the first time and can fight out the finish. IZASTEP (5) gets a narrow vote to score. MUELHEIMER PERLE (9) has been heavily raced this year but has also done well in this division before so can contest the finish. BAKHCHISARAY (2) has won a claimer before and is not out of it

EUR € 15,000**

1. PRINCESSE COLUMBIA - Her only win was on the PSF and she was 8th last time out in handicap at Lyon-Parilly over 1600m on 18 May. Others are preferred

2. PEPETE - Showed some improvement when third last time out in a claimer at Lyon-Parilly over 1600m on 8 June. Be right there at the finish

3. PRIVATE DINNING - Yet to win but was runner-up last time out in this division at Lyon-Parilly over 1600m on 8 June. Big chance in this line-up

4. BEST OFFER - Showed some improvement when runner-up last time out in a claimer at ParisLongchamp over 2000m on 6 June. Can go one better this time

5. SACHA SUNRISE - Has not shown his best in two starts this year and was 6th last time out in a Conditions race at Marseille-Borély over 2600m on 14 June. Capable of winning dropped to a claimer

6. KHELREGAL - Only fair so far and was 5th last time out in a claimer at Langon over this distance on 9 June. More is needed to win this race

Summary: A small field but a very interesting race. PRIVATE DINNING (3) showed improvement when runner-up in this division last time out and can go one better. PEPETE (2) was not disgraced when third last time out and should be concerned with the finish once again. SACHA SUNRISE (5) has been a disappointment this year but is not without a chance in this line-up. BEST OFFER (4) was a runner-up in this division last time out and is another to consider

**C8 - PRIX DE FOS-SUR-MER - 2000m (a1m1/4) - TURF - Maiden Race - Flat
- EUR € 21,000**

1. LOGIS - Well beaten in both starts on the PSF, with the latest being at Pornichet-La Baule over 1700m on 18 January. Can improve trying the turf

2. NOBLEMAN - Did not show his best when 9th last time out in a conditions race at ParisLongchamp over 2000m on 13 June. in good form before that and can bounce back to score

3. GRECIAN JEWEL - Not disgraced when 5th on her debut in a Conditions race at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 1900m on 25 May. Should improve and is not out of it

4. VULDETRADE - Disappointing last run when 12th in a handicap at Saint-Cloud over 1600m on 17 June. Consistent form before that and can fight out the finish

5. GATEAU DES ROIS - A three-year-old gelding by Catholic Boy out of La Fève who is making his debut. Watch the betting

6. LISE DE ROMAY - A three-year-old filly by Estejo out of Grey Delice who is making her debut. Watch the betting

7. GYMNOPEDIE - A three-year-old filly by Sea The Moon out of Catalyst who is making her debut. Watch the betting

Summary: A couple of these are on a recovery mission after flopping last time out . NOBLEMAN (2) is clearly better than his last run would suggest and can bounce back to score. VULDETRADE (4) disappointed last time out but was consistent before that and deserves respect. GRECIAN JEWEL (3) was not disgraced on debut and should improve. GATEAU DES ROIS (5) makes his debut and could be ready for this lucky last race
