- **3. LE TITIEN -** Delicate but capable of great performances when avoiding disqualification, especially with this shoeing configuration, in which he finished 3rd over 2725m last time at Grenade on 19 October. Not taken lightly
- **4. LE LITTLE CORSE -** Consistent performer with sound references and form credentials, including a last-start 3rd over 2550m at Beaumont on 5 October. Keep safe
- **5. LUZ DES CHARENTES -** Rapidly improving filly. Opened her account at Agen early this month (over 2575m) and confirmed that progress by following up over 2800m at Castera-Verduzan on 14 October. Warrants respect
- **6. LADY UP STAR -** Showed early promise but lost her way earlier this year before regaining momentum with a last-start win at Auch over 2250m on 2 September. Confirmation is expected with Frédéric Clozier engaged
- **7. LOVE QUEEN -** Progressive filly with sound/consistent references and solid form credentials, including a last-start 2nd (in this shoeing configuration) over 2800m at Castera-Verduzan on 14 October. Not taken lightly
- **8. LEXINGTON D'OYSE -** Debut winner in May at Montauban and confirmed that promise by finishing 2nd and 3rd in subsequent starts, either side of an Agen disqualification. Didn't go unnoticed when 6th at Beaumont 9 September
- **9. LINGOT CASTELETS -** Has made encouraging progress in 2 starts with this shoe-fitting. Confirmed the improvement of her 4th at Agen early this month by finishing 2nd over 2800m at Castera-Verduzan on 14 October dark horse
- **10. LOLITA DU PORHOET -** Unplaced (7th of 8 finishers) on debut over 2550m at Bordeaux on 20 October. Would've gained from the experience but is best watched for now
- **11. LAVANDE DU RIB -** Sparked improvement in this shoeing configuration to finish 4th over 2900m at Challans on 13 October. More needed
- **12. LUCKY AIMEF -** Consistent trotter with sound references/credentials, albeit with a victory (9-start maiden). Disqualified at Grenade-sur-Garonne on 19 October but shouldn't be hastily condemned
- **13. LEXINGTON DU BOURG -** Inconsistent but isn't devoid of ability. Finished 3rd on this course over 2950m last month but could only finish 7th over 2600m at Cazaubon-Barbotan on 30 September. Needs to reaffirm
- **14. LAORA DE BIRAC -** Runner-up in 2 of 3 completed races (4 starts), albeit at a lower level. Finished 6th at Castera-Verduzan over 2800m on 14 October, so needs to improve to make her presence felt

Summary: LOVER DE CHENU (1) was unlucky two starts back at Pornichet but did bounce back to winning form on turf last time out. He is taken to follow up back reverting to sand. LIEVRE D'ALBRET (2) has been knocking hard at the door and it would be no surprise to see him get off the mark. LE TITIEN (3) can be tricky but he is a smart trotter when applied. Hard to pass by. LE LITTLE CORSE (4) is well placed behind the autostart and is another one who has solid claims.
