- 1. FUSEE DE PORCHE Battle-hardened colt whose experience and form over this distance on turf stands him in good stead. Shouldn't be hastily condemned for finishing unplaced (10th) on PSF at Pau over 1400m on 19 October not taken lightly
- **2. PIC PEN -** Experienced colt with consistent references/form credentials, especially on turf. Didn't go unnoticed when 6th on PSF over 1400m at Pau on 19 October but should fare better on this surface
- **3. FRENCH CHUNKY -** Capable colt whose last start (7th) on 19 October over 1400m at Pau in his first outing on PSF isn't an accurate reflection of his ability. Has the form and experience to make his presence felt back on the turf keep safe
- **4. MARQUES -** Promising filly with untapped potential and scope for improvement. Has acquitted herself well in two starts in well-composed fields, finishing 3rd on both occasions the latest over 1600m at Clairefontaine on 22 October
- **5. DJOAHNA -** Finished a career-best 3rd in first-time headgear (retained here) on heavy ground over 1400m at Haras du Pin on 27 October. Needs to confirm that improvement
- **6. VALMACCA -** Unexposed filly with undeniable means and solid form references, albeit over further. Finished a good 3rd over 1700m at Marseille-Borely on 28 September
- **7. SHUTTERWOOD** Made no impression on debut at Tarbes (9th) and finished unplaced (8th) over 1200m at Dax on 6 October. Others preferred
- **8. DYNA CHOPE -** Unplaced in both starts, the latest (8th) with blinkers fitted over 1000m at La Teste on 10 April. Races without headgear on her reappearance and is best watched for now

Summary: MARQUES (4) has finished 3rd in both starts and needn't improve much over this shorter trip to open her account. VALMACCA (6) fits a similar profile and will be competitive for the leading places. Consistent BUFFALO WOMAN (10) has the means to join that fight for victory and isn't taken lightly on her reappearance. FUSEE DE PORCHE (1), who will appreciate the return to 1200m, has podium ambitions.

- **2. KAMAKURA ONE -** Experienced filly with sound/consistent form references, including a good 4th in her only handicap appearance. Caught the eye when finishing 3rd on very heavy ground over 1800m at Clairefontaine on 25 October respect
- **3. LOST IN MUSIC -** Confirmed the form/improvement of his comeback 5th at Tarbes with a last-start victory in a 1400m Bordeaux handicap on 5 November. Remains competitive under a 2,5kg penalty
- **4. BLOOD DIAMOND -** Bounced back to form with a reassuring 4th off this mark in a course-and-distance handicap on 23 October. Confirmation required
- **5. ROSADORA** Won a 1700m Divonne claimer in September and confirmed that form/improvement in 2 subsequent handicap appearances, the latest (4th) over 1600m on very ground at Nantes on 19 October. Not taken lightly

- **3. PIANINO -** Regaining momentum and proven at this level finished 4th in his last 2 appearances in the claiming category, the latest over 1700m at Marseille-Borely on 10 November. Dropped 1,5kg and shouldn't be underestimated

ALEXANDRINE DE GHAZAL (8), who also made a promising debut at this venue, and well-bred newcomer SAM'LAT AL SHAHANIA (10), especially under a light weight, appeal most of the remainder.

- **2. LUNATICOS** Rejuvenated 6-year-old gelding bidding to complete a hat-trick after wins at Nantes last month and at Le Mans in a 1950m handicap on 2 November. Candidate for success despite a 3,5kg penalty
- **3. VA S'Y MIX -** Experienced veteran handicapper with sound references/form credentials at this level, which include finishing 6th in consecutive recent handicap appearances the latest over 1900m at Bordeaux on 26 October. Outsider
- **4. AFRICAN GREY -** Inconsistent veteran who sparked improvement dropped to his current mark when 2nd in a 1900m handicap at Bordeaux on 26 October. Confirmation required

- 2. JAFAR D'ESCAR AA Won a similar contest over the same distance at La Teste in August and finished an encouraging 4th over 2300m at Tarbes on 20 October after a 2-month break. Will appeal to lovers of outsiders
- **3. VERTIGO POMPADOUR AA -** Debut winner on this course over 2000m in March 2023. Showed his form and well-being when finishing 3rd at Tarbes over 2300m in the key reference race on 20 October keep safe
- **4. INCROYABLE D'OC AA -** Ultra-consistent performer whose references include winning this race last year. Regained momentum recently and confirmed as much by finishing a respectable 5th over 2300m at Tarbes on 20 October
- **5. EMERYS DE LARACHI AA -** Consistent hard-knocker whose form and experience at this level augurs well for his chances here. Ran well in defeat when finishing 6th over 2300m at Tarbes on 20 October after a 2-month break

- **3. BASHEER -** Runner-up in a course-and-distance claimer on heavy ground in December 2023. Inconsistent in 3 appearances in handicaps recently, the latest (15th) on PSF at Pau over 2000m on 19 October should fare better at this level
- **4. DAYAL -** Lightly raced gelding with scope to improve on his reappearance, especially in his first start at this level. Absent since finishing 8th in a 2200m La Teste handicap on 22 July

Summary: ZALLAL AL SHAHANIA (3) has benefitted from cutting back in distance and she seems close to success. LINDOR DE BOZOULS (1), with first-time headgear fitted, and ZAKYNA AL ZARAYAN (4), in cheekpieces for the first time, aren't incapable of fighting for victory if bouncing back from disappointing recent performances. Supplemented HUALA (5) also a say on her reappearance.
