- 2. HAPPYJO DE LIGNY Pleased in Paris before winning a 2750m Class C here a week ago. Takes on better this time but is not to be discounted
- **3. FEE LUCERNAISE** Disappointing of late, most recently 9th of 13 in a 2850m Vincennes Class D earlier this month, and has no possible chance
- **4. HARRY CARISAIE** Failed to make the grade when 7th of 9 behind GOAL STAR (5) in a 2700m Vincennes Class B on 9 November, and is not about to spring a surprise

Held back for this in order to squeeze in on the front line, HAVE SEVEN (11) is hard to knock when barefoot, and represents the principal threat. As consistent as you like, and very much at home here, GABRIELLA DUEM (8) races barefoot for the first time and must be afforded significant respect. Currently second in the GNT standings, IBIKI DE HOUELLE (13) is barefoot for her first objective since the spell and even from the back line, can play an active role.

- 10. I SANTO DUSSAC In the frame in 2 of last 3, most recently 3rd of 15 in a 2725m Grenade Class F 2.5 weeks ago, but the extra 25m will do him no favours
- 11. IKY JOY Fine trotter that ran 4th of 16, on return from a break, in a 2725m Grenade Class E 2.5 weeks ago. Will have progressed for the run, appreciates Toulouse, and is unlikely to be far from the action
- **12. IANINA DES BORDES -** 4th over shorter here before finishing 10th of 13 in a 2400m Beaumont Class F on 13 October, and is unlikely to cause an upset
- **13. ISSALIO -** Reassuring 2nd of 12 in a 2150m Enghien claimer on 17 October. Has form here and is a possible spoiler. Attention
- **14. IZAYA DE COUSSERAT -** Useful type making first start since running 7th of 16 in a 2800m Auch Class E early-September. Front pads fitted but is worth keeping an eye on all the same
- **15. ICONE PLANCHETTE -** Won best race of her career when comfortably lifting a 2725m Cabourg Class E late-October. Is new to the venue but his trainer isn't and is very easy to like
- **16. IDOLE JALLERIE** Reassuring at Vire before being sanctioned in a 2875m Enghien Class D mid-October. Drops in category and, with the help of Eric Raffin, can trot his way back into the winners' enclosure

Summary: Wonderfully-entered at the limit of earnings, IDOLE JALLERIE (16) reverts to a previous configuration for her Toulouse debut and could well have her day in the sun, provided Eric Raffin keeps her stride in check. It's unlikely to be all plane sailing though considering how well ICONE PLANCHETTE (15) imposed at Cabourg. 25m better off and enjoying a productive run of form, ICARE DE LA BASLE (5) is shod as he was at Montauban and looks a player. Capable on a good day, IERONTO (7) benefits from an Alexandre Abrivard drive this time and should not be overlooked.
