- **4. GLAMOUR YOMA -** Unplaced in a class D at this track over 2150m on 13 November. Reverts to barefoot. Needs to find a few lengths
- **5. HAPPY DJOB -** Finished 7th in a class D at Bordeaux-Le-Bouscat over 2650m on 23 December. Poor form and is unlikely to be involved in the finish

- 2. JOYAU DE BELLANDE Consistent hard-knocker with sound references/form credentials, including a last-start 3rd (shod) over 2725m at Grenade on 22 December. Winning chance with shoes removed
- **3. JUNTA DES THIRONS -** Returned to form with a reassuring 4th in this shoeing configuration over 2400m at Bordeaux on 1 December. Keep safe
- **4. JANE LUIS PORSGUEN -** Sparked improvement when finishing 7th (shod) in a 2925m harness event at Cagnes on 28 December. Should have more to offer lightened in her shoeing
- **5. JASPER'S WAY -** Honest hard-knocker with sound references at this level with his irons (shod), including a last-start 5th on 1 December over 2400m at Beaumont. Dark horse
- **6. JACKPOT DES MONTS -** Thriving hard-knocker. Won consecutive outings before finishing 2nd over 2150m in his hat-trick bid at Cagnes last month (18 December)

Summary: JACKPOT DES MONTS (6) found only one too good last time in his hat-trick bid at Cagnes last month but this is a good opportunity for him to get back to winning ways. Consistent JOSS GRAND PRE (1) will give another competitive account of himself so could make life difficult for that rival. JOYAU DE BELLANDE (2), JUNTA DES THIRONS (3) and JANE LUIS PORSGUEN (4) appeal most of the remainder and should fight it out for the last podium berth.

- 2. KANADA DES RACQUES Inconsistent trotter won over 2550m at Gournay in September but finished unplaced in both subsequent starts, the latest (10th) over 2550m at Reims on 24 November
- 3. KLAXON DE REVILLE Inconsistent but has the means to acquit himself competitively and sound references, including a course-and-distance 4th in this (unshod) configuration last month. Shouldn't be hastily condemned for his Beaumont failure (10th) on 20 December
- **4. KALLISTO DE LASTEL** Inconsistent performer who is currently out of sorts unplaced in consecutive appearances after an earlier disqualification. Finished 7th over 2400m at Beaumont on 20 December
- **5. KIR DE KACY** Delicate trotter with undeniable means but seldom far from a fault. Finished a reassuring 4th in this (unshod) configuration over 2400m at Beaumont on 20 December confirmation expected
- **6. KOENING DE LA COUR -** Consistent hard-knocker with solid references/form credentials, including a last-start 6th over 2400m at Bordeaux recently (20 December). Keep safe
- 7. KANSAS LEMAN Versatile trotter maintaining his form/consistency alternating between the disciplines didn't go unnoticed (5th) in a 2425m mounted race at Angers on 9 December. Respected back in the harness category
- 8. KOLONEL MACKER Lightly raced trotter with the undeniable means to play a leading role. Unplaced (9th) over 2400m at Beaumont last month (20 December) when resuming after a 6-month absence but remains open to improvement
- **9. KALYPSO DE CHOC -** Versatile trotter with references in both categories seldom finishes far off the mark, even with his shoes on (shod). Didnt go when finishing 4th under the saddle in a 2200m mounted race at Langon on 21 September
- **10. KASSUS BLUE -** Revealed considerable promise in 2023, winning 2 of 4 starts (placed 2nd and 3rd in the others) but lost his way in 3 outings last year unplaced (13th) once and disqualified twice, the latest over 2400m at Beaumont on 1 November. Don't write off
- 11. KYLIAN DU CHATELET Relatively consistent trotter with sound references, albeit without a win (22-start maiden). Shouldn't be hastily condemned for finishing 10th in a course-and-distance contest on 6 December

Summary: Sparingly raced KASSUS BLUE (10) blotted his copybook in 3 appearances last year but showed enough during 2023 to suggest that he should be winning a race of this nature, especially given the potential for improvement in this shoeing configuration. KOLONEL MACKER (8) fits a similar profile and is another genuine candidate for success after a much-needed comeback outing. KIR DE KACY (5) and KLAXON DE REVILLE (3) aren't underestimated, while versatile KANSAS LEMAN (7) isn't taken lightly either after a pleasing performance under the saddle last month.

- 2. KALINKA DIEM Unreliable and unlikely to trouble the judge on the evidence of recent performances, the latest (7th) over 2400m at Beaumont on 20 December
- 3. KALITA MAUZUN Consistent hard-knocker with sound references/form credentials, including a last-start 5th on this course over 2950m back in late November. Dark horse
- **4. KUEEN KEP -** Experienced mare with sound references/form credentials seldom finished far off the mark. Didn't go unnoticed (6th) in a course-and-distance event when last seen on 28 October
- **5. KROSSBLADE** Inconsistent performer who is currently out of sorts soundly beaten in consecutive outings, the latest (7th) over 3100m at Nort-sur-Erdre on 15 September. Others preferred
- **6. KAILY DUEM -** Unplaced (11th) over 2400m at Beaumont on 20 December but would've benefitted from that much-needed reappearance. Better expected
- 7. KOCCINELLE BEY Regaining momentum and will likely play a leading role if repeating the performance of her last-start 3rd at Beaumont over 2400m on 20 December. Keep safe
- **8. KORALIE D'ISQUES -** Lightly raced mare with undeniable means and sound references/form credentials. Shouldn't be hastily condemned for her Beaumont failure (disqualification) on 20 December
- 9. KALPINA ORIENTALE Experienced 23-start maiden with sound references, albeit without a win seldom far off the mark and didn't go unnoticed (6th) over 2400m at Beaumont on 20 December
- **10. KOLOR** Complicated trotter with sound references but seldom far from a fault and out of sorts at present finished 10th over 2400m at Beaumont on 20 December

Summary: KATRINA DE MARZY (1) has rediscovered her form and consistency racing unshod. She finished an encouraging 5th at Angers last month and a repeat of that performance should suffice here in the 'Lucky Last.' She gets the nod ahead of KAILY DUEM (6), after a much-needed comeback outing, and lightly raced KORALIE D'ISQUES (8) who shouldn't be hastily condemned for a recent failure (disqualification). Of the rest, improving KOCCINELLE BEY (7) and consistent KALITA MAUZUN (3) are others with podium porpsects.
