- 11. JACKMAN Has two races under his belt since the break, most recently last but one behind JINGLE LOVER (14) in a 2100m Class C here last Friday. Barefoot this time and has a decent chance of opening his 2024 account
- **12. JOLI MANNEQUIN -** Blows hot and cold but gave a fine account 3 weeks ago, coming 3rd of 15 in a 2850m Class C here, and should be taken more seriously this time
- **13. JOLIVERT DU GERS -** Reassuring 3rd of 16 in a 2800m Rambouillet Class B early-October. Seldom lets the side down at Vincennes and will be expected to finish in the mix
- **14. JINGLE LOVER -** Could have finished closer than 6th of 14 in a 2100m Class C here last week if he had not been denied a run, and will not be available at 38/1 this time around. Place prospect
- **15. JEU COQUIN -** 6th of 9, on return to competition, in a Class B over course and distance mid-October. Is still being conditioned though and others easier to back
- **16. JOKER D'OCCAGNES -** Last but one behind JOLIVERT DU GERS (13), when preparing for this in a 2800m Rambouillet Class B on 6 October. Barefoot this time but would have better prospects on a more even surface

Summary: A wonderful example of reliability, JERENAL D'HAMELINE (10) took no time making his presence felt following the summer break and, unbeaten when barefoot, can make this his own. He will however face opposition from JACKMAN (11) who imposed over course and distance the last time he raced barefoot, and the complicated JOTUNN DU DOME (5) who finished in eye-catching fashion last time out. JINGLE LOVER (14) would have defied his odds here last Friday had he been afforded a run and Paul Ploquin will be eager to put things right.
