## C1 - PRIX DE BRIOUDE - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class D Race - Mounted - EUR € 59,000

**1. GUOPECK DE VIVOIN** - 3rd of 9 behind HELENA GIRL (5) in a 2850m Class D here on 8 November. Front pads fitted this time and best to hold off

**2. HANDSOME BOY** - Never far from faulting but has bags of ability, latterly unlucky 6th of 9 behind HELENA GIRL (5) in a 2850m Class D here on 8 November, but can make amends if Damien Bonne keeps him out of trouble. Chance

**3. HEVA BLONDE** - Sanctioned in 3 of last 4, latterly a 2850m Mauquenchy Class D last Wednesday, and backs up with limited aspiration

**4. GET UP BROWN** - Has failed to deliver at Vincennes recently, latterly sanctioned in 8 November race of reference. Has ability but first needs to re-establish his credentials

**5. HELENA GIRL** - Very good 2nd of 9 finishers in a 2850m Class D here over the inner track 9 days ago. In the money in all 3 ridden starts to date and is not about to break the mould

**6. HOUARNEAU** - Fine servant that ran 4th, behind HIMALAYA NARCY (11), in a Class D under these conditions late-October, and has a realistic chance of making the frame this time

**7. HARIBO DU CARNOIS** - 4th of 15 in a 2900m Challans harness Class E on 13 October. Adrien Lamy on board for ridden bow and will have his supporters

**8. GRINGO SAVA** - Unable to confirm good Enghien performance when sanctioned in 29 October race of reference, and others easier to trust

**9. HARAGONAIS** - Impressive 2nd of 10 finishers, on comeback, in a 2875m Enghien Class D mid-October. Mathieu Mottier in the irons again and will not be going home empty-handed

**10. GRAZIELA D'EL** - Last but one when being conditioned in a harness Class D over course and distance last weekend. Has done nothing noteworthy for some time and, even shod to preference, is unlikely to make any impact

**11. HIMALAYA NARCY** - Won a brace before running 2nd of 8 in a Class D over track and trip late last month. Has taken superbly to her new vocation and can enjoy another day in the sun

**12. HEDEN CRUZ** - Back in the code after running 5th of 11 in a 2850m Parilly harness Class C on 10 October. Seldom puts a foot out of place in this branch of the game and returns to racing shod with a good hand to play

**13. HIMBERLAND** - Has 2 runs in him since the break, most recently sanctioned in a 2450m Caen Class D on 12 October, but seems to be off the boil and can be passed over

**Summary:** Like a horse reborn since switching codes, HIMALAYA NARCY (11) missed out on the hat-trick under these conditions late last month, but Denis Brossard has found a fine opportunity to set the record straight. Nathalie Henry will still be keeping a keen eye on the temperamental but talented HANDSOME BOY (2) who rarely disappoints over 2700m here, and HOUARNEAU (6) who finished a place ahead of him in the race of reference. HELENA GIRL (5) has demonstrated significant promise and a repeat of her latest performance would see her go close.

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C2 - PRIX D'AIGUES MORTES - 2100m (a1m1/4) - Class D Race - Harness - EUR € 56,000

1. **HYPER FAST** - Has not been seen out since finishing 12th of 13 in a Class D under these conditions mid-September, and is unlikely to shake things up
2. **HOLD UP DES VENTES** - Has 2 races in him since the summer break, most recently 6th of 13 behind GETEHI DU NOYER (6) in a 2850m Laval Class D 9 days ago, and has a lot more to find
3. **GAROU DU CHENE** - Authoritative winner of a Class D under these conditions on 25 October. Has a lot going for him this time and Alexandre Abrivard will be eager to confirm Paul Ploquin's success
4. **HOLD UP RANAIS** - 3rd over track and trip before finishing 8th of 15 in a 2875m Meslay Class E early-October. Reunited with JMB, could not have hoped for a better draw, and will be no pushover
5. **GOLDORACK** - Last but one in a 2200m Caen Class B on 20 October. Shod to preference this time but still has no possible chance
6. **GETEHI DU NOYER** - Reassuring 3rd of 13 in a 2850m Laval Class D 9 days ago. Has form over 2100m here and, in current condition, will not be far off the mark
7. **HAIDA SAUTONNE** - Drops in category after finishing 8th of 10 in a 2600m Gr.3 at La Rochelle last weekend. Form is not in question and Benjamin Rochard will be justifiably aiming at a place in the mix
8. **HOSTIA** - Sanctioned in a 2700m Class D here last weekend. Reliability not her strong suit but, given the entry, deserves to be taken seriously
9. **HALO AM** - Completed the hat-trick in a 2850m Lyon-Parilly Class C on 10 October. Won over track and trip on penultimate start and is not incapable of defying the draw and imposing
10. **HASHTAG CHAMANT** - Imposed over 2700m here before finishing 13th of 14 in a 2150m Mauquenchy Class D on Wednesday. Would have preferred a better draw but nonetheless backs up with a respectable chance of making amends
11. **CERTAINLY (SWE)** - Returns to Vincennes not having been seen out since finishing 9th of 12 over 3140m in Kalmar on 20 September. Has never delivered here and is not about to start
12. **HERMES D'ECROVILLE** - 5th to GAROU DU CHENE (3) in a Class D under these conditions on 25 October. Is plainly in decent shape but neither the draw nor the company will suit his objectives
13. **HYDROMEL** - Starts for first time since faulting in a 2600m Cavaillon Class C on 20 September. Appreciates the main track but will have his work cut out this time
14. **MISTER DONALD** - Somewhat unlucky 11th of 14 in a 2150m Mauquenchy Class D last Wednesday but still has too much to do
15. **VERSACE FACE** - Serious nordic sort making first appearance since finishing last but one over 2140m at Hagmyren on 22 September. Not ideally-drawn but is as versatile as they come and should not be underestimated
16. **ADAMO DIPA** - 9th of 11 in a Class E over course and distance on 11 October. Form heading in wrong direction and must first reaffirm

**Summary:** Winner over course and distance late last month, setting a personal best of 1'10"5, GAROU DU CHENE (3) sports the same configuration, has been handed a good draw, and is in with a shout of doubling his money. Contrastingly less-fortunate with the draw, HALO AM (9) nevertheless returns to Vincennes on a 4-timer and can pull it off if Yoann Lebourgeois successfully negotiates the start. HOLD UP RANAIS (4) ran well here in September before and delivering an oddly-below-par effort at Meslay-du-Maine, but is clearly close to his race and looks a major player. GAROU DU CHENE (3) made up for his Caen blip with a solid Laval effort and, breaking in front, is unlikely to disappoint.

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## C3 - PRIX RMC (PRIX DE MANDELIEU) - 2175m (a1m1/4) - Class D Race - Mounted - EUR € 46,000

- 1. IRON MAN D'AVRIL** - Tricky character that made short work of a 2800m Strasbourg Class F on 25 October. Barefoot this time but still not a priority
- 2. IMAIL DE CARSI** - 3rd of 10, when preparing for this, in a 2450m Caen harness Class E last weekend. Has previously won over the main track but is unlikely to shake things up
- 3. LET IT BE VP** - 6th of 11 in a 2700m Machecoul harness Class E a fortnight ago and will have nothing to contribute
- 4. BEAUTIFUL BOY(ITY)** - Surprise 4th of 9 to MISTER INVICTUS (7) in a 2725m Cabourg harness Class D mid-October, but is not about to repeat
- 5. INDICE DU CAIEU** - Quickly sanctioned in a 2875m Argentan Class E a fortnight ago. Placed just once in 5 over 2175m here, but tends to go well for Alexandre Abrivard and can make up for Argentan sanction
- 6. STACCATO HL** - Serious German trotter that flew up in a 2250m Enghien Class E on 19 October. Top driver in the bike this time and has a realistic chance of making the frame
- 7. MISTER INVICTUS** - Returned to competition in cracking form, latterly dominating a 2725m Cabourg harness Class D a month ago. Is plainly at the top of his game and can bring the fight to IN YOUR EYES (10)
- 8. HAVRE DE PAIX** - Unraced since finishing last of 12 in a 2750m Pornichet Class E mid-August. Races barefoot for re-entry but still hard to recommend
- 9. LUCKY GUY BOKO** - Drops in category after running 6th of 11 in a 2850m Class C here a month ago. Is a tough nut to crack and debuts in the discipline with Mathieu Mottier on board and a good hand to play
- 10. IN YOUR EYES** - Runner-up in 2 here last month, latterly a 2700m Class D on 29 October. Enjoys a fabulous entry, has never disappointed at Vincennes, and is not about to start. Claim
- 11. HIRO DE L'ORMERIE** - Sanctioned in a Class D over course and distance on 22 October. Has otherwise been showing his form and, on good behaviour, can contest the finish

**Summary:** A veritable star in this branch of the business, IN YOUR EYES (10) simply excels here, and the new distance may be just what's required to unblock his Vincennes account. MISTER INVICTUS (7) though has shown significant versatility and, first time barefoot at Vincennes, will be no soft touch. German 6yo, STACCATO HL (6), is as tough as they come and the engagement of Benjamin Rochard will only work in his favour. HIRO DE L'ORMERIE (11) is nicely-engaged here and, sporting a new configuration, will not be far off the mark if focused.

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## C4 - PRIX DE BRETAGNE-AMERIQUE RACES Q1 - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Gr2 Race - Harness - EUR € 120,000

- 1. IDEAL LIGNERIES** - Won a 3000m Nantes Gr.3, first time back, on 6 October, at 12/1, but still seems to be biting off more than he can chew
- 2. JUST LOVE YOU** - 3rd of 15 in Criterium des 5 Ans before coming 3rd to EMERAUDE DE BAIS (12) in 2575m Gr.2 Grand Prix du Sud-Ouest at Agen on 23 October. Has excellent references over 2700m here, is plainly back in shape, but others still preferred
- 3. KRACK TIME ATOUT** - 3rd of 8 finishers in 2100m Gr.1 Grand Prix de l'UET here on 11 October. Has 2 Gr.1s to his name but, against his elders, will struggle to make his mark
- 4. JOSH POWER** - Won Gr.1 Criterium des 5 Ans before finishing 6th of 12, when prepping for this, in 2100m Gr.2 Prix Marcel Laurent here last weekend. Seems to be getting better with age and is very much in the running
- 5. INA DU RIB** - Last of 16. On first start for 7 months, in a 2875m Argentan Class A 2 weeks ago. Has other priorities and can be passed over
- 6. BANDERAS BI** - Won in Norway and Italy before running 7th of 13, behind GANAY DE BANVILLE (9), in Gr.1 UET Final over 2100m here early-October. Alessandro Gocciadoro knows what it takes to win here and could yet make qualifying first-4
- 7. KANA DE BEYLEV** - Has not been seen out since being sanctioned in Gr.1 2850m Criterium des 4 Ans here mid-September. Races shod this time and best to hold off
- 8. INMAROSA** - Disappointed in 2 before coming 4th of 11, a place behind GANAY DE BANVILLE (9), in 2850m Gr.3 Prix des Cevennes here late last month. A repeat however, looks particularly unlikely
- 9. GANAY DE BANVILLE** - 2nd in Gr.1 UET Final before running 3rd of 11 in 2850m Gr.3 Prix des Cevennes here late last month. Has received the thumbs-up from his driver and must be afforded respect
- 10. HUSSARD DU LANDRET** - 2023 winner facing first objective of the season, latterly last but one behind GANAY DE BANVILLE (9) in a 2850m Gr.3 here on 31 October. Shod as he was at Enghien and is not incapable of pulling off the Bretagne double
- 11. HOKKAIDO JIEL** - Decent 5th of 11, when preparing for this, in a 2850m Gr.3 here late-October. 3rd in 2023 running, has 2 races under his belt, and can play a leading role. Chance
- 12. EMERAUDE DE BAIS** - Impressive winner of 2575m Gr.2 Grand Prix du Sud-Ouest at Agen 3.5 weeks ago. Is never easy to gauge but, if still on the boil, will not be far from the action
- 13. IDEALE DU CHENE** - 9th of 11 in a 2850m Gr.3 here 2.5 weeks ago. Preparing for a campaign under the saddle and can be ruled out
- 14. JUST A GIGOLO** - Showed his form even though sanctioned in 2100m Gr.2 Prix Marcel Laurent here last weekend, but looks to have too much to do
- 15. SAN MOTEUR** - 4th of 11 in a 2640m Åby Gr.1 late-September. 6th in 2023 edition, is hard to fault in the day's configuration, and looks a player

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**16. DON FANUCCI ZET** - Hardy Swedish raider making first appearance since running 4th in a 1609m Jägersro Gr.1 late-July. Ran 6th in 2023 Prix d'Amérique but, with just hind shoes off, is unlikely to influence the result

**17. AMPIA MEDE SM** - Produced 2 good efforts in September before coming 6th behind GANAY DE BANVILLE (9) in Gr.1 UET Final over 2100m here early-October. Goes over any distance and, in current shape, may well be the one to beat

**18. HOOKER BERRY** - 3rd in Gr.1 UET Final before running 4th to EMERAUDE DE BAIS (12) in 2575m Gr.2 Grand Prix du Sud-Ouest at Agen on 23 October. 2nd 12 months ago and Nicolas Bazire has been talking him up. Attention

**Summary:** A classy trotter with nothing to prove at this level, AMPIA MEDE SM (17) was by no means disgraced in the Gr.1 UET Elite Circuit Finale last month after having run 2nd in the competitive Grand Prix de Wallonie, and looks eminently capable of winning this. Théo Duvaldestin will have his antennae honed to HOKKAIDO JIEL (11) who is barefoot for his first objective of the winter, and 2023 winner, HUSSARD DU LANDRET (10) who has been reconfigured following a trio of conditioners. [Surprise] Winner of the Critérium des 5 ans, JOSH POWER (4) held his own when being prepped in good company, and barefoot this time, is unlikely to go down without a fight.

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C5 - PRIX PIERRE PLAZEN - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Gr2 Race - Harness - EUR € 120,000

- 1. LAGNU MAG** - Unlucky to be sanctioned in a Gr.3 over course and distance on 8 November. Reverts to a previous formula, always gives his best, but appears to be out of his depth this time
- 2. LEONARDO ROC** - Showed improvement when 3rd of 7 in a Gr.3 over course and distance 9 days ago, but still not an obvious choice
- 3. LIGHT MY FIRE** - Returns to Vincennes on a hat-trick, most recently winning a 3000m Nantes Class B with ease 11 days ago. Has previously placed under these conditions but looks more a minor place prospect this time around
- 4. LUCKY SIBEY** - Here for a change of scenery after running 7th of 11 in a 2700m monté Gr.2 here late-October, and will have nothing to contribute
- 5. FELDENKRAIS PAL** - Sanctioned in last 3, most recently 1600m Premio Vittorio Guzzinati in Turin on 1 October. May have more luck in France but, with front pads fitted, is unlikely to cause an upset
- 6. LEMON TREE** - Serious colt that has had the benefit of 3 conditioners, latterly 9th of 15 in a 2850m Laval Class B on 1 October. Has never disappointed when sporting pads and should not be overlooked
- 7. LUCKY JACKSON** - Sanctioned early in 25 October race of reference when clearly in tip-top form. Has references at this level but others easier to trust
- 8. LUTIN DES BORDES** - Never at his ease when 6th of 10 finishers in 2450m monté Gr.1 Saint-Léger des Trotteurs at Caen on 12 October. Has other priorities and can be disregarded
- 9. LARGO DE CASTELLE** - 4th of 6 finishers to LOMBOK JIEL (13) in 2175m Gr.2 Prix Victor Regis here on 25 October. Unlikely to get his nose in front but can nevertheless pick up a slice of the pie
- 10. LOULOU DE MYE** - Made up for lacklustre Criterium performance when missing out by little to LOMBOK JIEL (13) in 2175m Gr.2 Prix Victor Regis here on 25 October. Has talent in spades and can again finish close
- 11. LUCIANO MENUET** - Sanctioned when full of running in 2175m Gr.2 Prix Victor Regis here on 25 October. Could have finished closer in Criterium and will have his chances if Yoann Lebourgeois keeps him out of trouble
- 12. FRANK GIO** - 2nd of 9 finishers to FIRST OF MIND (14) in 2100m Gr.1 Derby Italiano at Le Capannelle on 13 October. Boasts a remarkable French record, races shod to preference, and is not to be underestimated
- 13. LOMBOK JIEL** - Runner-up in Critérium des 3 Ans before winning 2175m Gr.2 Prix Victor Regis here on 25 October. Is among the best of his generation and in the absence of LOVINO BELLO can return to victorious ways
- 14. FIRST OF MIND** - Derby Italiano winner making French debut after running 2nd in 1600m Paolo E Orsino Mangelli in Turin early this month, and will be dangerous if he takes to the new profile

**Summary:** A class act that won the Gr.2 Prix Victor Regis here after having enjoyed a magnificent summer, LOMBOK JIEL (13) returns to racing with 4 pads fitted and will justifiably garner the lion's share of support. He is going to be pitted on this occasion against Italian Derby winner, FIRST OF MIND (14), who sports front pads for the first time, and LUCIANO MENUET (11) who will be expected to bounce back from his Victor Regis sanction. Close 2nd that day, LOULOU DE MYE (10) will have been kept on the boil and is not about to let the side down.

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C6 - PRIX GUY DELOISON - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Gr2 Race - Harness - EUR € 120,000

- 1. FRECCIA** - Returns to Vincennes after finishing 2nd of 7 finishers in a 2100m Wolvega Gr.2 a fortnight ago. Sports front pads for first time and will be worth monitoring
- 2. LERIKA DU CHENE** - Lost her action early in a 2175m Class B here last weekend. Has ample ability but needs to get her house in order
- 3. LOOKING FRANCE** - Placed over the inner track before running 7th of 13 in a 2175m Class B here last weekend, and is being aimed too high
- 4. LOVE GLORY** - 3rd of 13 in a 3000m Nantes Class B earlier this month. Untried at this level and is not about to influence the outcome
- 5. LITTLE STAR FLEURY** - 8th of 10 to LUNABELLA D'OMAHA (9) in a Gr.3 over course and distance 9 days ago, and will need too show marked improvement
- 6. LUSH LIFE** - Sanctioned in 1600m Gran Premio Orsi Mangelli in Turin on 1 October. Showed his form in Prix Uranie though and, shod to preference this time, can finish in the mix
- 7. LYZIA DES AGETS** - Races here for a change of scenery after faulting in a 2700m monté Gr.2 here 2.5 weeks ago, and can be disregarded
- 8. LUNA NOVA GWEN** - Tricky sort that was sanctioned in 2175m Gr.2 Prix Uranie here on 25 October. Is confirmed at this level and can play a part if Yoann Lebourgeois keeps her trotting
- 9. LUNABELLA D'OMAHA** - Has won 6 of 7 starts to date, most recently a Gr.3 over course and distance, with authority, 9 days ago. Steps up in class but still looks a major player
- 10. LA JOYEUSE WICZ** - Sanctioned early in 2175m Gr.2 Prix Uranie here on 25 October. Did land a Gr.1 last winter and, already a winner for Alexandre Abrivard, can get a look-in
- 11. LOTTA BOURBON** - 3rd in Gr.1 Critérium des 3 Ans before running 7th of 8 to LIZA JOSSELYN (14) in 2175m Gr.2 Prix Uranie here on 25 October. Is clearly in top shape though and boasts an ex excellent record with Eric Raffin. Chance
- 12. LITTLE ORELIE** - 3rd of 11, a place behind LEXIE DE BANVILLE (13), in a monté Gr.2 over course and distance 2.5 weeks ago. Has other priorities though and can be ruled out
- 13. LEXIE DE BANVILLE** - Back under harness after running good 2nd of 11 in a monté Gr.2 over course and distance 2.5 weeks ago. Would be preferred under the saddle however
- 14. LIZA JOSSELYN** - Exceptional filly that won 2175m Gr.2 Prix Uranie here on 25 October. Set the record straight after her Criterium sanction and will be expected to book her berth into the big race
- 15. FUNNY GIO** - Serious Italian filly that won a prestigious mile race in Turin early this month. New to Vincennes, has never been tested beyond 2100m, but still looks a serious proposition

**Summary:** Unsurprisingly like her mother, LIZA JOSSELYN (14) has talent to burn. She flew up in the Gr.2 Prix Uranie late last month, and if applied, will take some beating. Leading the opposition is LOTTA BOURBON (11) whose recent Prix Uranie performance should not be misinterpreted, and the wonderfully-consistent FUNNY GIO (15) who, despite sporting just front pads, still looks dangerous. LUNABELLA D'OMAHA (9) has yet to be bested in 4 Vincennes starts over course and distance and is ignored at one's peril.

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C7 - PRIX DE BOISSY-SAINT-LEGER - 2100m (a1m1/4) - Gr3 Race - Harness - EUR € 80,000

1. **JEWELCANDLE FAC** - Last but one when being conditioned in a 2850m Laval Class A early this month. Has form at the highest level and Damien Bonne will be keen to get her straight back in the game
2. **GERICAULT** - Hardy element making first appearance since finishing 7th of 11 to JUST A MIDI (6) in a 2875m Enghien Gr.3 last July. Shoes off but may just be a race shy
3. **JEEGHA PRIDE** - 13th of 15, behind KHAL'S FELLA (11), in a 2700m Gr.3 here on 25 October, on first start back. Sports a new configuration but cannot be considered a player this time
4. **KANADA** - 4th of 11 in a 2875m Argentan Class A conditioner 2 weeks ago. Competitively-shod for first time and from 4-spot will have a lot to contribute. Chance
5. **DESIDERIO D'ESI** - Makes first appearance since being sanctioned in a 2850m Gr.3 here on 24 September. Not the most dependable but is confirmed at the venue, and with Eric Raffin in the bike for first time, will be afforded every chance
6. **JUST A MIDI** - Unable to confirm Criterium performance when last but one in a 2700m Gr.3 here on 25 October. Entrusted to Paul Ploquin for first time, races unshod-behind, and from the front row looks to have a good hand to play
7. **DANGER BI** - Won in Naples before running 2nd of 6 over 2200m in Hamburg early last month. Is new to Vincennes but starts in front and, considering his Swedish form in particular, looks competitive for a place in the mix
8. **DEMON** - 5th of 9 in 2100m Gran Premio delle Nazioni in Milan 3 weeks ago. Races barefoot this time but may nevertheless find the going tough
9. **KEEN WINNER** - 5th of 15, a place behind KHAL'S FELLA (11) in a 2700m Gr.3 here on 25 October. Has been handed the 9-spot but still looks good enough to win this
10. **JAGUAR MARANCOURT** - 8th of 15 in a 2700m Class B here late-October. Yoann Lebourgeois reining this time but others still preferred
11. **KHAL'S FELLA** - Ran a very good 4th of 15 in a 2700m Gr.3 here on 25 October. Starts on back row but consistently gives his best and has a realistic chance of opening his winter account
12. **HNOKKI SPEED** - Danish import that has yet to deliver at Vincennes, latterly sanctioned in a 2850m Class A here on 7 September. Comes here fresh, barefoot, but with limited ambition
13. **JAMIN DE BRION** - 10th of 16 on return to competition in a 2875m Argentan Class A 2 weeks ago. Has delivered just once over track and trip, but goes barefoot this time, and will have his supporters
14. **DARDO ZACK** - Has not been seen out since running 4th of 10 in a 2875m Enghien Class A last April. Shoes on and no threat
15. **KELLE BEAUTE** - Justifiably well-regarded but quickly sanctioned in a 3000m Nantes Class B 11 days ago. Competitively-shod but the draw will do her no favours
16. **KEMIA DU CHENE** - 6th in Criterium des 4 Ans before finishing 8th of 12 in a 2700m Class B here last weekend. Handed a rough draw and others easier to back

**Summary:** 5th in the Criterium des 4 Ans, finishing a place behind KEEN WINNER (9), KHAL'S FELLA (11) had her measure in the Gr.3 Prix Pierre Van Troyen here next time and, while neither can be considered well-drawn, preference nevertheless goes to Franck Nivard's charge. KANADA (4), on the other hand, is ideally-positioned behind the car and sports a new configuration for the occasion. The classy JEWELCANDLE FAC (1) has 2 runs in her since the long absence, is barefoot, and despite the inside draw, can still play a prominent part.

C8 - PRIX DE COSSE LE VIVIEN - 2100m (a1m1/4) - Class C Race - Harness - EUR € 68,000

1. **ILLUSION JIPAD** - Superb winner, on return to competition, in a 2700m Class A here late last month. Jean-Michel Bazire maintains faith and, despite the draw, will still be no easy touch
2. **GILMOUR** - 11th of 14, when being conditioned, in a Class B over course and distance earlier this month. Shoes on again and others easier to back
3. **SELF EXPLOSIVE** - Returns to France after running 6th of 9 in 2100m Gr.1 Gran Premio Delle Nazioni at San Siro 3 weeks ago. Ran 2nd on lone appearance under these conditions and, given his form, must be retained
4. **GINO VIVA** - Consistent type dropping in category after running 5th of 14 in a 3000m Nantes Gr.3 earlier this month. Boasts excellent speed under these conditions and must be afforded respect
5. **GLOBAL AGREEMENT** - Unbeaten in 7 starts in France, latterly winning a 2850m Class C here on 22 September. Thrives over 2100m on the main track and, from the 5-spot, will take all the beating
6. **HERE WE GO** - Has 3 runs in him since the break, most recently 8th of 15 behind GIPSY DE CHAMANT (9) in a 2700m Class C here 2.5 weeks ago. Enjoys a good spot in front and will be thereabouts at the finish
7. **GREAT OF MADRIK** - Disappointing this term, latterly 6th of 15 behind GIPSY DE CHAMANT (9) in a 2700m Class C here 2.5 weeks ago, and is unlikely to improve on that
8. **ICONE MADRIK** - Imposed at La Capelle before running 2nd of 13 in a 2850m Class D here a fortnight ago and given his liking for these conditions, looks main rival to GLOBAL AGREEMENT (5)
9. **GIPSY DE CHAMANT** - Excellent in last 2 here, latterly coming 3rd of 15 in a 2700m Class C here 2.5 weeks ago. Does not benefit from the best of draws but, in current form, is very easy to like
10. **EROS ZOLA** - Has not been seen out since winning over 2140m in Aalborg 2 months ago. Is unbeaten in 3 starts over course and distance though and, racing barefoot, will be one to keep an eye on
11. **ENJOY THE GAME** - 11th of 15, on first start since July, behind GIPSY DE CHAMANT (9) in a 2700m Class C here 2.5 weeks ago. Will have come on for the run, has solid 2100m credentials here, and can play a role if Nicolas Bazire extricates himself early
12. **ILLENC DES BOSCH** - 13th of 16, on comeback, in a 2200m Caen Class B on 20 October. Races shod again and can be passed over
13. **MARION FOUTY BON** - 7th in race of reference before finishing last of 7 in a 2175m monté Gr.2 here 2 weeks ago, and cannot be considered a player
14. **HERMES ANGEL** - Good dual-discipline type that ran 3rd of 10 in a 2625m Agen monté Class D 3.5 weeks ago. Shoes on though and poses no danger
15. **CHARMY CHARLY AS** - Convincing winner, on re-entry, in a 2875m Argentan Class A 2 weeks ago. Entrusted to Alexandre Abrivard this time but the draw will do him no favours
16. **IES WE KAN** - Last of 9 in a 2175m monté Class B here early-October. Reconfigured this time but still not an obvious choice

**Summary:** A simply remarkable campaigner, GLOBAL AGREEMENT (5) has been transformed since coming to France and, hard to fault when fresh, should be able to wrap this up. Back on the boil after a pair of uninspiring conditioners, ICONE MADRIK (8) starts wide but appreciates these shorter trips and looks the main danger. HERE WE GO (6) was not over-taxed here recently, but returns to his distance of preference and is well-placed to give this a good go. Winner on her first start for 4 months, when reined by JMB, ILLUSION JIPAD (1) is not incapable of doubling up.

C9 - PRIX JEAN MAURICE BETEAU - 2850m (a2m) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 35,000

1. **KABYLIE DE BOMO** - Runner-up in last 2, latterly of 9 in a 2700m Graignes Class F last Monday. Rejuvenated since being reconfigured but takes on too much
2. **KIRA D'OBRET** - Improving filly stepping up in category after winning a 2275m Nantes Class E 3 weeks ago. Faces a tough test this time but will, as usual, give what she can
3. **KALINE DU LOCHEUR** - 3rd of 14, on first start since June, in a 2800m Rambouillet Class B early last month. Has merit but is unlikely to shake things up this time
4. **KIARA DES MONTS** - Made no impact on return to the track, coming 12th of 14 in a 2850m Laval Class E last Monday, and even racing barefoot, will have nothing to offer
5. **KELLISIA GIRL** - 10th of 14 when being conditioned for this in a 2850m Laval Class E 9 days ago. Is dynamic when barefoot and focused, and has a reasonable chance of opening her winter account
6. **KARA DE PIERREPONT** - Sanctioned in a 2800m Rambouillet Class B on 6 October. Reconfigured for the occasion, and Matthieu Abrivard reining this time, but would have better prospects in the other code
7. **KALINA DES LUCAS** - Won in Kalmar last month before coming 2nd of 14 in a 2850m Laval Class E 9 days ago. Nicolas Bazire back in the bike and has a reasonable chance of picking up a cheque
8. **KUNZITE D'EM** - Sanctioned when unsupported in a 2100m Class E here on 5 November. Currently off the boil and can be ruled out
9. **KYNTÉ FLUSH** - Last but one, on first start since the spell, in a 2100m Class E here earlier in the month. Hind pads fitted this time but others still preferred
10. **KEVIVE DE MAIL** - Has yet to disappoint when barefoot, latterly 3rd of 12 in a 2200m Class D here 2.5 weeks ago. Has no references over the main track but still looks capable of getting in on the action
11. **KALINE DE FAEL** - Makes Vincennes debut after smartly winning a 3125m Angers Class E on 20 October. Takes on some better elements here but still looks up to the task. First 5
12. **KERRA UP STAR** - Unraced since finishing 9th of 11 in a 2875m Enghien Class D mid-August. Pads fitted for return but others still easier to back
13. **KAPELLA DAIRPET** - 5th of 10, on first start back, in a 2100m Class D here a month ago. Has had time to recuperate and can challenge for the win this time
14. **KAROLENE D'ETANG** - 7th of 11, on first start since February, in a 2750m Cabourg Class D 3 weeks ago. Has already won over the main track and can do so again if Damien Bonne keeps her focused
15. **KIMMERIDGIENNE** - Hardy filly that finished 8th of 10 in a 2100m Class D here a month ago. Should be at peak fitness by now and looks significantly more competitive this time around

**Summary:** Twice a winner here last season, KAROLENE D'ETANG (14) has had just the one conditioner since returning to competition but she is shod to preference and, if applied, can get straight back in the game. KELLISIA GIRL (5) won her last 2 barefoot runs and, after 2 re-entry races, will be no shrinking violet. Victorious at Enghien before being sent for a rest, KAPELLA DAIRPET (13) left a good impression on comeback here mid-October, will have progressed for the run, and is unlikely to be far from the action. 8th that day, KIMMERIDGIENNE (15) did not live up to expectations, but she enjoys a fabulous entry and Franck Nivard will be eager to take advantage.

C10 - PRIX DU CHER - 2175m (a1m1/4) - Class F Race - Mounted - EUR € 36,000

- 1. JADE DE BLARY** - Put on a fine show after being sanctioned in a 2850m Mauquenchy Class F a week ago. Sports modified shoeing and should not be written off
- 2. JOIE DE VIVRE** - Ran a flattering 6th here before being sanctioned in a 2850m Mauquenchy Class F last weekend. Is not devoid of ability but others still preferred
- 3. JUMACHA** - 4th of 9, at 105/1, in a 2850m Mauquenchy Class F last Sunday, but a repeat seems most improbable
- 4. JOKARIA ORIENTALE** - Boasts fine monté references but has not raced since running 2nd of 12 in a 2750m La Capelle Class F last May. Barefoot for re-entry but may need the race
- 5. JULIANA BREIL** - 13th of 14 in a 2500m Saint-Brieuc harness Class F 2 weeks ago. Flopped on lone ridden outing and, even going barefoot, cannot be considered a priority
- 6. JOY MARANCOURT** - Enjoying rich vein of form over past 2 months, most recently 3rd of 9, behind JAMAICA D'OYSE (12), in a 2450m Caen Class F last weekend. Steps up in category but is not to be overlooked
- 7. J'ADORE CHENEVIERE** - 6th of 13 in a 2700m Graignes Class F a fortnight ago, on just 2nd appearance in the code, but is not about to cause an upset
- 8. JONCTION HAUFOR** - 10th of 15 in a 2750m Cabourg harness Class E 3 weeks ago. Reverts to a previous formula for monté debut but is unlikely to spring any surprises
- 9. JANICK DU VIVIER** - Opened her ridden account at first time of asking, dominating a 2375m Castelsarrasin Class F a week ago. Pitted against better here but has never disappointed in the day's configuration and will have her supporters
- 10. JASMINE DANCER** - Not at her ease, but evidently in shape, when 6th of 10 in a 3000m Nantes Class F 11 days ago. Is in her category and, reconfigured for Vincennes debut, should not be far off the mark
- 11. JENY DE GOUYE** - Makes just 2nd appearance in the discipline after being sanctioned in a 2825m Parilly harness Class B early last month. Races shod and will have few takers
- 12. JAMAICA D'OYSE** - Close 2nd of 9, on monté debut last weekend, in a 2450m Caen Class F. Comes to Vincennes with morale intact and, in current condition, is very easy to recommend. Chance
- 13. JALNA DU BUISSON** - Returns to the ridden code after finishing last of 12 in a 2150m Enghien harness Class E a month ago. Anne Barthélemy in the saddle this time and must be taken seriously
- 14. JACANA DE BLARY** - Sanctioned early in a 3000m Nantes Class F 11 days ago. Has bags of ability for this category and can make this her own if she gets off on the right foot
- 15. JOYEUSE D'OCCAGNES** - Unraced since winning a 2900m Arras Class E on 22 September. Has had ample time to get back in shape and, considering the entry, will have a lot to offer

**Summary:** Although not the easiest of horses to gauge, the reconfigured, JACANA DE BLARY (14) has been entrusted to Benjamin Rochard for the occasion and can win this if he manages to keep her focused. That said, JAMAICA D'OYSE (12) went close on her recent monté debut and the engagement of François Lagadeuc will do her prospects no disservice. Nicely-engaged at the limit of earnings, JOYEUSE D'OCCAGNES (15) got back in the winners' circle last time out and, fresh for her return, will be expected to play another active role. JALNA DU BUISSON (13) is seldom seen in the discipline but has shown potential and sports a fresh formula for the occasion.
