- 3. KENNEDY STREET Has turned a corner since starting to race barefoot, most recently finishing 5th of 13 behind KISS ME DU LIVET (6) in a 2850m Class D a fortnight ago. Cannot be considered a priority but should nevertheless hold her own
- **4. KEYS -** Has climbed the category-ladder in good order, most recently running 2nd of 14 in a 2700m Class D here 3 weeks ago. Stable enjoying rich vein of form and although untried over 2175m, should still be retained

- 6. KISS ME DU LIVET Surprise 5th of 14 behind KINDY DU VIVIER (11) in a 2100m Class D here 8 days ago. Has that 'little extra' on occasion and cannot be discounted
- 7. KLASSE DE BRUZEAU Raced better behind KINDY DU VIVIER (11) in a 2100m Class D here 8 days ago than her 9th of 14 would suggest. In this company however, will have too much to do
- **8. KEA DES RACQUES -** Returned to the winners' circle, for first time in 12 months, when comfortably securing a 2100m Class E here 3 weeks ago. Front pads fitted again and will not be going home empty-handed. Place chance

- **7. LONG LEGEND -** Sanctioned over main track before coming 5th of 12 in a 2850m Class D over the short course 2.5 weeks ago and again looks competitive for a first-5 payout
- **8. LUNE DE L'EMION** Easy 2nd of 5 finishers in a 2850m Class E over the short track on 28 November, and returns to the long course with a realistic chance of finishing in the mix

- 2. MILORD JAVRONNAIS Takes a big step up after winning 2 at Graignes, lastly a 2700m Class B on 11 November. Should adapt well to new profile but appears to be taking on too much this time
- **3. MILAN -** Not disgraced when 5th of 12 to MACK DE BLARY (9) in a Class B over course and distance a fortnight ago but will need to find more this time
- **4. MISTRAL DU GOUTIER** Ran an honourable but unthreatening 4th to MONZON NORMAND (12) in 2200m Gr.3 Prix Louis Cauchois on 18 October, and cannot be considered a priority
- **5. MAGICO DE LOU -** Defied his odds to run 4th of 12 to MACK DE BLARY (9) in a Class B over course and distance 2 weeks ago, but a repeat seems improbable
- **6. MAT MANATHIS -** Tenacious 2nd of 12 to MACK DE BLARY (9) in a Class B over course and distance 2 weeks ago. Steps up in category but has shown potential and can pick up a thin slice of the pie

- 2. ILIO MANNETOT Has twice shown he is plainly back in the game, most recently winning a 2850m Mauquenchy Class F with ease a month ago. Pitted against a better bunch this time but can still play a small role
- **3. IPSO DU FER** Failed to confirm Enghien performance when a one-paced 8th of 12 behind IDEFIX D'OLMEN (7) in a 2100m claimer here 3.5 weeks ago, and can be confidently disregarded
- **4. IDEFIX DHELPA** Honest trotter but failed to make the grade when 7th of 8 to IRIS INTENSE (12) in a 2100m Class D here on 29 November, and once again appears to have his work cut out
- **5. IPSOS DE BANVILLE -** Has hardly put a foot out of line all year, lastly winning a 2800m Vire Class E in good order 3.5 weeks ago. Steps back up in category but front shoes off for first time and looks a respectable first-5 chance
- **6. IGGY POP DE CHENU** Appears to have come off the boil, latterly 9th of 14 in a 2850m Class E here last Saturday, and must get his house in order
- 7. IDEFIX D'OLMEN Never threatening when sanctioned in a 2100m Class D here a fortnight ago and is not about to shake things up
- **8. IMOKO ATOUT -** Tricky sort that won superbly at Maure before being sanctioned in a monté Class D over course and distance 2.5 weeks ago. With application though, his place is on the podium

It's often a case of all-or-nothing for IMOKO ATOUT (8) but after a change of scenery under the saddle, he will be no pushover if applied. A tough nut when focused and barefoot, IDEAL DE RIVRAY (9) proved the point at Chartres and the services of JMB have been engaged for the occasion.

- **2. FERAHAN AS -** Drops in class after running 5th of 8 in a 1600m Turin Gr.1 early last month. Shoes on here and with Alexandre Abrivard in the bike for first time, is unlikely to disappoint
- **3. LAPIS LAZULI -** Excellent 2nd to the good Lionheart in 2700m Gr.3 Prix de Château-Thierry here on 8 November. Enjoys an excellent entry and will take all the beating
- **4. LEARN TO FLY -** Back in the harness code after faulting in a 2700m monté Gr.3 here on 21 November. Won a Mauquenchy Class A a week earlier though and from the 4-spot should not be far from the action
- **5. FIDELIS DANCE -** Unremarkable 4th of 5 over 2120m at San Siro a fortnight ago. Has references under these conditions but may be taking on too much this time

- **4. HALICIA BELLA -** Good, consistent mare that finished 4th of 12 in a 2700m Class B here 3 weeks ago. Takes on some better horses this time but has solid references over this distance and the draw will do her chances no disservice

- **6. GALLAGHER WIND -** Quality element that was sanctioned when preparing for this in a 2175m Class C here last Saturday. Sports pads this time but still not an obvious choice
- **7. FERRERO DU LOISIR** 7th of 10 behind GARANCIO BELLO (16) in a 2700m Class C here a fortnight ago. Has little liking for Vincennes and cannot be considered a player

- **8. KAPORAL DES FORGES -** Sanctioned, when clearly in form, in a 2850m Class A here on 22 November. Always gives his best and although not a contender should nevertheless give an honourable account
- **9. JINGLE DU PONT -** Last of 10 in 2700m Gr.3 Prix de Chenonceaux here 3 weeks ago. Shoes on again and can be disregarded
- **10. DANA EK -** 8th of 10 in 2700m Gr.3 Prix de Chenonceaux here 3 weeks ago. Is considerably better than that, will be more suited to this trip, and can finish in the mix if Jean-Philippe Monclin positions her early
- **11. RIKITA JP -** 9th of 14 in a 2700m Gr.2 here last Saturday. Has looked very ordinary this season and will have little to contribute

Summary: A talented nordic import, WORKING CLASS HERO (2) has won 2 of 3 at Vincennes, most recently in style over course and distance, and will take some beating. Mathieu Mottier will still be keeping an eye on DESIDERIO D'ESI (1) whose latest performance was particularly encouraging, and the ultra-consistent EDGAR SABA (7) whose recent re-entry will not have gone unnoticed. Alexandre Abrivard perseveres with DEMON (4) whose day is not far off.

- 1. GOLD DE JADE Encouraged at Mauquenchy before finishing 9th of 10 in a 2825m Class F conditioner at Le Croise-Laroche late last month. Has a lot going for him here and appears to have the measure of most
- **2. SILVER BULLIT(SWE)** Returns to the ridden code after having run 4th of 12 in a 2950m Toulouse harness Class E on 20 November. Pierre-Yves Verva gets the nod here and is not to be overlooked
- **3. EL VALEROSO -** Last but one in a 2100m harness Class D here 8 days ago. Pleased last time under the saddle but a different configuration would be preferred
- **4. FELINE DE JANVILLE -** Currently enjoying a productive run, most recently 4th of 12 in a 2400m Amiens harness Class E on 1 December. Is difficult to fault in either code at the moment and must be regarded a serious player
- **5. GOUNIT DE L'AIROU -** 10th of 13 behind GRANDE SOIREE (6) in a 2825m Cordemais Class E 3 weeks ago. Has shown some monte potential but insufficient to be considered a priority
- **6. GRANDE SOIREE -** Debuts in the discipline after finishing 8th of 13 in a 2825m Cordemais Class E 3 weeks ago. Front pads fitted but appears to have a mountain to climb
- **7. MADE OF STARS** Has not put a foot wrong for months, most recently 3rd of 11 in a 2625m Class E at La Rochelle on 9 November. Is new to Vincennes but is plainly close to his race and will justifiably garner support
- **8. GORESTAN -** Last of 13 behind FULL CASH DE PADD (12) in a 2700m harness Class D conditioner at Le Croise-Laroche 12 days ago. Has 2 races under his belt, with hind shoes off, and the Eric Raffin-factor cannot be ignored
- **9. STARO MOJITO -** Finished 5th of 12, close to SILVER BULLIT(SWE) (2) in a 2950m Toulouse harness Class E on 20 November. Is no slouch when focused and can get in on the action if he can keep his stride together
- **10. FANDANGO GLYCINES -** Last of 7 in a 2175m Class E here on 2 December and latest numbers do nothing to inspire confidence
- **11. GOLD PEJI -** Takes first competitive ridden steps after finishing 7th of 12 behind SILVER BULLIT(SWE) (2) in a 2950m Toulouse harness Class E on 20 November. Benefits from a good entry and will be worth monitoring
- **12. FULL CASH DE PADD -** Returns to the code after running 2nd of 13 in a 2700m harness Class D at Le Croise-Laroche 12 days ago. Lacks credentials though and with shoes on is not about to cause an upset

Summary: A very good servant when focused, and solid under these conditions, GOLD DE JADE (1) is behind in earnings, races with just front shoes, and with Mathieu Mottier in the bike, can win for the first time since his lengthy absence. FELINE DE JANVILLE (4) however has done nothing but please lately and even with front pads fitted, still looks the main threat. As consistent as they come, MADE OF STARS (7) is easy to recommend. STARO MOJITO (9) may have placed just once in 3 under the saddle but is shod to preference and present form bodes well for his chances.
