- **1. JOBOURG MESLOIS -** Won at Strasbourg before running 4th of 8 in a 2200m Class E here late last month. Faces a better bunch this time however and chances limited
- **2. MERCEDES STAR -** Opened ridden account at Wolvega early-November before faulting over 2100m at the same venue next time, but is barefoot on this occasion, with Mathieu Mottier aboard, and can play an important part
- **3. JAGUAR DE VILLETOT -** Pleasantly surprising 4th of 11 in a 2175m Class E here on 11 December. Is plainly on way back up and will generate some interest
- **4. JACK BARROW -** Back in the code after coming 4th of 14 in a 2100m harness Class D here on 25 November. Did run 3rd in Gr.1 Saint-Léger des Trotteurs in 2022 though and, sporting modified shoeing, can get in on the action
- **5. JAGUAR DE KARA -** 2nd to JACARANDA (11) on monté debut before being sanctioned in a 2100m harness Class D when prepping for this earlier this month. Paul Ploquin back in the saddle and looks a major player
- **6. NATURAL MINE -** Makes ridden bow after running 3rd of 8 under harness over 1640m at Romme late last month. Westholm-trained runners in cracking form at present and must be taken seriously
- **7. JAG ROYAL -** Won 2 of last 4, latterly a harness Class E over course and distance. Gets on well with his jockey and, if form transitions, he should be in a position to challenge for the spoils
- **8. JOCE JISCE -** Lacklustre 5th of 7 finishers, a place behind JAZZY THOURJAN (10), in a Class D under these conditions 3 weeks ago, and can be confidently ruled out

JAGUAR DE KARA (5) ran 2nd to him on his monte debut that day and, reconfigured, can again get in on the action, but may first have to defer to the good JAG ROYAL (7) who is primed for a return to the discipline. Swedish visitor, NATURAL MINE (6) debuts at Vincennes, and under the saddle, but has been entrusted to Alexandre Abrivard who will be looking to capitalise on his charge's current form.

- **3. LOLITA BOURBON -** 6th of 11 behind LAMIE DU MESNIL (4) in a Class B over course and distance on 13 December. Sports 4 pads this time but has been deserted by Eric Raffin and not a priority
- **4. LAMIE DU MESNIL -** 4th of 11 in a Class B over course and distance on 13 December. Has started to make progress but still represents no more than a minor place prospect
- **5. LILI DRY -** 7th of 11 behind LAMIE DU MESNIL (4) in a Class B over course and distance on 13 December and will have few friends

- **12. IDOLE D'OURVILLE -** Ran 6th in an elevated Class D before being sanctioned in a 2700m Class D here on Wednesday and backs up with modest aspiration
- **13. INES QUICK -** Failed to make it 4 in a row when sanctioned in a Class E over course and distance 2 weeks ago. JMB gets the nod this time and is unlikely to pass up such a good opportunity
- **14. IDYLLE DU PERSIL -** Reassuring 3rd of 9, a place behind IDOLE STAR (2), in a Class E over track and trip 2 weeks ago. Takes on a better lot on this occasion and is unlikely to spring any surprises
- **15. ILLUSION D'AMOUR -** Convincing winner of a 2100m Class D on 2 December. Eric Raffin in the sulky this time and will not go down easily
- **16. ISIS D'HERFRAIE -** 5th of 16 in a Class D over course and distance early last month. Comes here fresh, enjoys a good entry, but still no more than a minor place prospect

Summary: After having won 3 on the trot, INES QUICK (13) quickly lost her action next time but has been reconfigured and with Jean-Michel Bazire in the bike can make amends and set the record straight. IZZIE D'ERONVILLE (5) had been going good-guns before being denied a run here earlier in the month, but she enjoys a 25m head-start, goes barefoot, and will have her chances if Anthony Barrier keeps her out of trouble. ISIA DU CHENE (9) has buckets of talent and is reunited with Alexandre Abrivard who is unbeaten with her. Winner over 2100m 3 weeks ago, ILLUSION D'AMOUR (15) is barefoot this time and even from the back row looks a major player.

- **1. KASPAROVA -** Makes just 2nd monte start after finishing 10th of 13 in a harness Class E over course and distance earlier in the month. Is reconfigured and could pleasantly surprise with Eric Raffin in the irons
- **2. KARRY WHITE -** Won last 2 under the saddle, most recently a Class F under these conditions on 6 December. Takes on a much better lot this time though and chances appear slim
- **3. KALIE D'URSIN -** Sanctioned 8 times before finishing last of 10 in a 2850m harness Class E 12 days ago and has no realistic chance
- **4. KRYSEIS -** Authoritative winner of a Class E over track and trip on 18 November, on monte debut. Returns with morale intact and Adrien Lamy will be legitimately eyeing the double
- **5. KRISTALE D'ERABLE -** Was making up ground on the leader when 2nd of 5 finishers in a 2200m Class E here late last month. Excels in the day's configuration and is not about to disappoint
- **6. KISS ME JO DARLING -** 4th at Reims before finishing 7th of 11 behind KACEY BELL (7) in a Class D over course and distance on 25 November, and will need to find significantly more
- **7. KACEY BELL -** Somewhat lacklustre 5th of 11 in a Class D under these conditions on 25 November. Proved in October that she is patently better than that and can finish in the frame this time
- **8. KALINE DU RIB -** 7th of 9 behind KALINA PRINCESS (12) in a Class D over course and distance 2 weeks ago despite a slow start. Has previously won at this level and is not incapable of making first 5 this time
- **9. KISS ME DOMPIERRE** Back in the discipline after finishing last of 11 in a 2175m harness Class D here last weekend. Shoes on again but could just get a look-in
- **10. KALLAS IN SALLAZ -** Sanctioned, on return to competition, in a Class D over course and distance 2 weeks ago. Barefoot this time but others still preferred
- **11. KAMILLE D'AUTHISE -** Unremarkable 8th of 9 behind KALINA PRINCESS (12) in a Class D over course and distance 2 weeks ago. Is a far cry from being at her best and will need another run
- **12. KALINA PRINCESS -** Fine 3rd of 9 in a Class D over course and distance 2 weeks ago, first time under the saddle. Will have come on for the run and has a realistic chance of imposing her will

Summary: Perfectly-engaged at the limit of earnings, and impressive on her ridden debut here earlier in the month, KALINA PRINCESS (12) races barefoot this time and can open her account. She will however be pitted against KRYSEIS (4) who stormed up on her own monte bow here mid-November, and who will be barefoot this time. KACEY BELL (7) ran 2nd to her that day and can again play a part, but she may first have to see off KRISTALE D'ERABLE (5) who came close to securing her first objective of the winter.
