- **3. KALYPSO DU CAUX -** Got off the mark at Reims before coming 3rd of 10 finishers, some distance behind KEILA TREMBLADAISE (10), in a Class F over course and distance on 6 December, but can still pick up some prizemoney
- **4. KANA DE SUCE -** 7th of 10 finishers, some distance behind KEILA TREMBLADAISE (10), in a Class F over course and distance on 6 December, and can be confidently passed over
- **5. KARINE DU DOLLAR -** Made it 4 sanctions in a row when faulting in a Class E over course and distance 3 weeks ago. Has yet to finish a monte race unscathed but has been reconfigured, will be partnered by Alexis Collette, and must be respected

- **17. JOSH POWER -** Comfortable winner of 2850m Gr.2 Prix du Bourbonnais 3 weeks ago. Reconfigured this time and handed a shocking draw, but Eric Raffin will expect to at least get a sniff of the action

- **2. LOULOU DES OUBEAUX -** Switches to main track for first time after comfortably winning a 2200m Class D here on 4 December. Unlikely to repeat but can still trot his way into the money
- **3. LOUSTIC DE SALOMAX -** Has taken well to Vincennes conditions, most recently 2nd of 11 in a 2100m Class D here 3 weeks ago, and can again trot his way onto the podium
- **4. LITTLE DRAGON -** Got off the mark over the inner course late-November but finished last of 10 behind LOTUS GRIFF (5) in a Class B over course and distance 2.5 weeks ago, and cannot be considered a player
- **5. LOTUS GRIFF -** 7th of 10 finishers in a Class B over course and distance 2.5 weeks ago. Front pads fitted this time but has no love for the main track and others preferred
- **6. LINDSTEDT -** 5th of 13 in a Class C over course and distance 11 days ago. Consistently gives his best, has decent references here, and will have legitimate claims on a first-5 payout
- 7. LUDIVER DES VAUX Sanctioned in 4 of last 5, latterly a 2850m Mauquenchy Class A on 13 December. Has evident ability but must first get his house in order
- **8. LE SAP -** Last of 5, on first start back, in a Class B over course and distance a month ago. Won his first 4 though and, sporting 4 pads for the first time, is not to be underestimated
- **9. LUXOR DE VILLABON -** Showed significant early promise but has been disappointing lately, most recently sanctioned in a Class B under these conditions a month ago, and others easier to back
- **10. LAST MAN -** Quality colt making first appearance since running 2nd of 12 in a 2850m Class C over the inner track on 22 October. Clearly in competition-mode however and has every chance of winning this
- **11. LORD DE BANVILLE -** Sanctioned for 2nd time in a row when faulting in a Class B under these conditions 2.5 weeks ago and can be confidently passed over
- **12. LE CAP -** Moderate sort starting for first time since being sanctioned in a 2750m Class B at La Capelle early-September. Shod for return and can be ruled out

Summary: Excellent when racing with 4 pads, LAST MAN (10) may not have been seen out for over 2 months but Mathieu Mottier's yard is in cracking form and can keep his course-and-distance record intact. He is still going to face stiff resistance from the promising LORD DU GERS (1) who sports hind pads for the first time, and LOUSTIC DE SALOMAX (3) who has never failed to deliver over the main track. Last of 5 on last month's return to competition, LE SAP (8) has been reconfigured and will be no soft touch.

- **1. LOUXOR DE PIERRAIS -** Sanctioned, on career debut, in a Class E under these conditions late last month. Adrien Lamy aboard this time but others still preferred
- **2. LUKOMEDES -** 7th of 9 behind LOVE ME DO MESLOIS (14) in a 2200m Class E here on 13 December. Stable in flying form and will be no pushover if Mathieu Mottier keeps him trotting
- **3. LOVE DE BEAULIEU -** Sanctioned in a 2750m Cabourg Class F on 17 December. Yet to display much aptitude for the code and can be ignored
- **4. LASCAUX DEL PHEDO** Imposed at Chateaubriant before running 4th of 9 finishers, a place behind LOVE ME DO MESLOIS (14), in a 2200m Class E here on 13 December. Is not about to let the side down but is unlikely to surprise either
- **5. LIVE MY DREAM** Pleased on monte debut before being sanctioned in a 2200m Class E here on 13 December. Is plainly a colt of considerable potential and if applied should be able to prove the point
- **6. LITTLEBOY DE PLANY -** Sanctioned in last 2, most recently a 2700m Class D here 9 days ago, but given the chance to express himself, can pick up a cheque
- **7. LARPENT CELESTE** Lost his maiden status in a 2825m Cordemais Class F on 24 November. Is new to Vincennes though and others easier to back
- **8. LANINO -** Opened his account when dominating a 2750m Cabourg Class F on 17 December. Pitted against better this time but has been entrusted to Eric Raffin and will generate interest
- **9. LUCERO TEJY -** Steps up in category after winning a 2700m Graignes Class F on 12 November. Has freshness on his side, Benjamin Rochard in the saddle, and will not be far off the mark at the business end of affairs
- **10. LORD SMART** Finished 2nd of 7 finishers in a 2175m Class D here on 6 December only to lose it in the stewards' mobile-office. Paul Ploquin stays faithful and will be hopeful of getting him off the mark
- **11. LICARI -** 4th over track and trip on ridden debut last month before finishing 5th of 9 finishers, a place behind LOVE ME DO MESLOIS (14), in a 2200m Class E here on 13 December. Disregard
- **12. LEON DE LA COURBE** 5th here mid-November prior to faulting in a Class C over track and trip a month back, and has little to offer
- **13. LOTUS DES SABLES -** 3rd of 9, on return from a break, in a 2700m Class E here on 26 November. In better company this time but will have progressed and must be taken seriously
- **14. LOVE ME DO MESLOIS -** Clear 3rd of 9 finishers in a 2200m Class E here on 13 December. In similar company on this occasion and will be expected to make the podium once more

Summary: Disqualified from 2nd place on his ridden debut here earlier in the month, LORD SMART (10) will be fitted with front pads this time and can set the record straight. He is still going to encounter a padded LIVE MY DREAM (5) who has similarly shown significant potential, and the wonderfully-engaged, and reconfigured, LOVE ME DO MESLOIS (14) who takes to the main track after having twice pleased over the inner course. LUKOMEDES (2) cannot boast the cleanest of formcards but he will be fully-padded for his main-track bow.
