- **3. LUCIA DI JENILAT -** Has major disqualification issues but was runner-up last time out in a Class F Mounted race at Châteaubriant over 2400m on 1 December. Has a winning chance if smart again

- **5. KAMEHAMEHA** Inconsistent colt with sufficient means to acquit himself competitively, especially with Björn Goop at the helm. Not hastily condemned for finishing 9th in a 2700m Group II harness race here on 7 December

- **4. HURIEL LUDOIS -** Versatile trotter with references in both codes seldom finishes far off the mark on a going day but most effective unshod. Finished 5th in a 2200m mounted race at this venue on 20 December watch for now
- **5. HORS BORD -** Runner-up to HURRICANE CARTER (13) in a 2100m harness race at this venue on 2 December. Should play another leading role

- **3. JEDEO DES VAUX -** Delicate trotter, seldom far from a fault disqualified in 4 of his last 5 starts, including consecutive recent outings the latest on this course in a 2175m mounted race on 11 December. Best watched for now
- **4. JASMIN DANOVER -** Versatile trotter with references in both trotting codes seldom finishes far off the mark on a going day. Disqualified in a 2175m mounted race on this course (resuming after a 7-month absence) on 11 December
- **5. JOBOURG MESLOIS -** Inconsistent but has references in this configuration under the saddle. Unplaced (8th) on this course in a 2700m mounted race on 22 December for another day
- **6. JOMIZIO -** Consistent for the most part but is a tricky customer disqualified in 2 of his last 4 starts, the latest on this course in a 2175m mounted race on 11 December. Shouldn't be hastily condemned
- 7. JAFF DE MESLAY Honest hard-knocker who seldom finishes far off the mark but has no more than a place chance here after finishing 6th on this course in a 2175m mounted race on 11 December
- **8. JASMINE DE FORGAN -** Complicated mare with sound references but seldom far from a fault, though usually acquits herself well when remaining wise. Shouldn't be hastily condemned for finishing 10th at Le Mans on 16 December

JERIKA DE KERYANN (12), ideally engaged, and JIMINY CRICKET (9), whose debut under the saddle was encouraging, aren't taken lightly and should acquit themselves competitively, along with Damien Bonne's new recruit JOMIZIO (6).
