# C1 - PRIX DE BRIONNE - 2850m (a2m) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 52,000

**1. HEARTBEAT THUNDER -** Only modest of late and was 7th in Class C at Vincennes over 2700m on 29 December. More is needed to win this race

**2. CHITCHAT** - Unreliable but was runner-up last time out in Class D at this track over 2100m on 27 December. Better that distance but is not out of it

3. H.C.'S CRAZY HORSE - Disqualified last time out at this track on 4 January. Capable of playing a minor role at very best

**4. JOTUNN DU DOME -** Has a very good recent record at this track and was victorious in Class C here over 2700m on 29 December. Can follow up

**5. CHESTNUT (SWE)** - Remains in good form and was third in Class D at this track over 2100m on 27 December. Better this distance and should contest the finish

**6. DRAGOWSKI** - A bit of a disappointment of late and was 7th in Class A over this course and distance on 4 January. Needs to do a bit more to beat these rivals. Might place

7. CAIO TITUS BOND - Very consistent of late and was third at Turn over 1600m on 20 December. Tougher task in this line-up

**8. REVEN DEJAVU -** In good shape and was not disgraced when fourth in Class D at this track over 2700m on 28 December. Has a winning chance

**9. HERMES PAT** - Battling to find best form and was 6th in ClassD at this track over 2100m on 3 January. Needs to find a few lengths to win

**10. JIBI DU FRUITIER** - On a long losing run but was third in Class B at this track over 2100m on 25 December. Could earn some minor money

**11. INSTINCTIF** - In good form and was third in Class D over this track and trip on 1 January. Has a place chance

**12. JANZIBAR** - Did not show his best when 8th in Class A over this track and trip on 4 January. Likely to improve and can make the frame

**13. LUCKY GUY BOKO** - In good shape and was fourth last time out in a Class E Mounted race over this track and trip on 22 December. Could earn some more money

**14. BOCCADAMO** - Has struggled of late and was tenth in Class A at this track over 2100m on 3 January. Others are preferred

**Summary:** JOTUNN DU DOME (4) boasts a very good record over the Vincennes outer track and looks the one they all have to beat in this opener. Main rivals include Scandinavian raider REVEN DEJAVU (8) who is expected to come on a lot from his recent run at the venue and CHESTNUT (SWE) (5) who was not beaten far last time out. CHITCHAT (2) posted an eye-catching finish in his last outing and is definitely short-list material. Unshod on all four feet this time, JANZIBAR (12) can spring a surprise.

**1. MASSADA -** A three-year-old filly by Brillantissime out of Hariola who is making her debut. Watch the betting

**2. MALICE CAILLERIE** - Finished fourth on her debut in a Class D Mounted race at this track over 2200m on 31 December. Might earn some more money

**3. MARQUISE JISCE -** Not disgraced when fourth on debut in a Class C harness race over 2100m on 20 December. Has a winning chance trying a Mounted race

**4. MINA DRY -** Not disgraced when runner-up in a Class F Mounted race at Argentan over 2300m on 15 December. Can go one better this time

**5. MALICE SPEED -** A good winner on debut in a Class F Harness race at Nantes over 2275m on 17 November. Can follow up if in the same mood

**6. MANAMA D'ORLY -** Unreliable but was third last time out in a Class D Mounted race at this track over 2200m on 11 December. Has a place chance

**7. MYRTILLE MARBOULA -** Showed some improvement when third in a Class D Mounted race at this course over 2200m on 31 December. Could make the frame

**8. MISS DES BESACES -** Showed improvement when winning a Class D Mounted race at this track over 2200m on 11 December. Should fight out the finish

**Summary:** A half-sister to a Group 1 winner in the Mounted code, MALICE SPEED (5) won well first time out under harness and makes most appeal on her debut in this discipline. MISS DES BESACES (8) showed significant progress when scoring at Vincennes and has more to offer. MINA DRY (4) was a good finisher at Argentan and should get off the mark soon. Associated with Eric Raffin, MARQUISE JISCE (3) is worth a good look in on debut in this Mounted code.

**1. MAJESTEDARCHE -** A three-year-old filly by Roc Meslois out of Dryade Darche who is making her debut. Watch the betting

**2. MAGIC NIGHT -** Disqualified in both starts, with the latest being at Enghien on 10 October. Looked unlucky that day and can be a real threat if smart this time

**3. MANOU DU CHENE -** Improving and was 5th last time out in Class F at Argentan over 2300m on 4 January. Needs to do more to beat these rivals

**4. MANDRAGORA FLEURY -** Finished third on debut at Alencon over 2650m on 6 October. Likely to need this run returning from a break

**5. MY PRINCESS -** Ran well on her debut when third in Class F at Nantes over 2275m on 27 October. Big chance if fit from a break

**6. MARIE JOSE LABELLE -** Disqualified last time out at this track on 6 December. A good winner of her debut before that and has a winning chance if smart this time

**7. MARIA DE VALNY -** Has improved of late and was third in Class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 6 January. Has a place chance

**8. MADRID HAUFOR -** Finished 6th last time out in Class D at this track over 2850m on 14 November. Won on debut before that and is not out of it

**9. MA PASSION -** Improving and was fourth in Class D at Cabourg over 2050m on 2 January. Might play a minor role

**10. MIRZA DU BOUILLON -** Did not show her best when 8th in Class D at Cabourg over 2050m on 2 January. Needs to do a lot more to beat these rivals

**11. MAGIC GIRL** - Unreliable and was tenth in Class C at this track over 2100m on 20 December. Did better in her penultimate start and can upset

**12. MY SAVE QUICK -** Ignore the last run at this course on 7 January. Had some fair form before that and could make the frame

**Summary:** MY PRINCESS (5) made a promising debut at Nantes behind two well-regarded fillies and with the natural improvement can get off the mark this time around. MAGIC NIGHT (2) seems to have ability but needs to stay wise to score. MARIE JOSE LABELLE (6) has the assistance of Jean-Michjel Bazire and should leave behind her last effort. MADRID HAUFOR (8) has enjoyed a little break since her last below-par appearance and can bounce back to score.

**2. L'ETOILE DU LUPIN -** Disqualified last time out at Cordemais on 24 November. Capable of better but others are preferred

**3. LUCIA PERRINE -** Disqualified last time out at Chateaubriant on 6 January. Remains barefoot and is capable of improvement but others make more appeal

**4. LIESSE DU CHENE -** Showed improvement when barefoot and runner-up in a Class F Mounted race at Cordemais over 2825m on 5 January. Remains unshod and has a place chance

**5. LASKA DU LEVANT** - Disqualified in her first five starts but was a good winner last time out in a Class F Mounted race at Laval over 2850m on 8 December. Can double up if in the same mood

**6. LADY DES CHAMPS -** Disqualified in five of 7 starts including last time out at this track on 1 January. Not out of it on best form

**7. LADY GODIVA -** Unreliable and was disqualified last time out at Angers on 8 January. Capable of a surprise when wise

**8. L'IMPERIALE AR -** Disqualified last time out at this track on 1 January. Remains barefoot but has yet to win. Has a winning chance in this line-up if smart

**9. LA SOL FA -** Yet to win a race but was not disgraced when fourth in a Class E Mounted race at this track over 2200m on 1 January. Barefoot for the very first time and could earn some more money

**10. LIGHT UP ONE -** Disqualified last time out at this track on 1 January. Not easy to trust but is capable of making the frame if smart

**11. LUARIA -** Disqualified in four of six starts, including last time out at this track on 1 January. A runner-up twice in a row before that and can score if wise this time

**Summary:** L'IMPERIALE AR (8) has shown enough so far to think she can win a race like that. She needs to stay wise in the early part of the race and if so, can get off the mark. LUARIA (11) can also prove a handful but has a lot of ability and would not be a shock winner. LASKA DU LEVANT (5) managed to keep her stride in check at Laval and won with a lot in hands. LADY DES CHAMPS (6) is a case of all or nothing.

1. DEPP DELL'OLMO - Disqualified last time out at Enghien on & October. Not easy to trust but is capable of being competitive if wise this time

**2. MOST WANTED PK -** Yet to win a race and was 7th last time out at Wolvega over 2600m on 20 December. Needs to do more to beat these rivals

**3. DEMIDOFF CLA -** Consistent in Italy and was 5th last time out at Follonica over 1600m on 15 December. Can make the frame this distance

**4. MODRIC RENKA -** A winner of his last six starts, with the latest being at Wolvega over 2600m on 13 December. Can score again

**5. DAUPHIN JOYEUSE -** Hard to trust and was disqualified last time out at Turin on 31 December. Might play a minor role at very best

**6. PRESTO D'AN -** On a long losing run but did show improvement when runner-up at Mons over 2300m on 24 December. Has a place chance

**7. JOKER DE VOUEDE -** Has really struggled of late and was disqualified last time out at this track on 3 January. Needs major improvement to win

**8. MISTER JUPITER -** Disappointing of late and was 9th at Solvalla over 2640m on 2 October. Capable of doing better but may need this run

**9. JOLICOEUR -** Returned to form with a good third at Halmstad over 2140m on 2 December. Can contest the finish again

**10.** D J DEI VELTRI - Not disgraced when third at Turin over 2060m on 4 December. Has a place chance in this line-up

**11. JOUR D'ERABLE** - Unreliable and was 9th in Class F at Cabourg over 2750m on 23 December. Capable of a surprise when in the mood

**12. JAZZ PETTEVINIERE -** Disqualified last time out at this course on 27 December. Very unreliable but is capable of being the surprise package of the race

**13. JOYAU DE MORTREE -** Has been struggling for some time now and was 9th in Class E at Pontchâteau over 2800m on 22 December. Needs major improvement to win

**14. JOG DE JAVIE -** Showed vast improvement when barefoot and fourth in Class E at Pontchâteau over 2800m on 22 December. Remains unshod and could play a minor role

**15. JOKER CASTILUANNE -** Unreliable and was 8th in Class E at this track over 2100m on 10 December. Won his penultimate start and has a winning chance

**16. JOURNAIO DU ROI** - Did not show his best when 13th in Class E at this track over 2100m on 10 December. In good form before that and is not out of it

**Summary:** A winner of fourteen of his twenty career starts, MODRIC RENKA (4) makes a much awaited debut at Vincennes and must be worth siding with. JOLICOEUR (9) bounced back to form in Scandinavia last time out and can make a big impact on his debut at this course. JOKER CASTILUANNE (15) is well entered and can be included in calculations. DEMIDOFF CLA (3) is one to follow in his first run for his new trainer.

**2. LOUBIANA DU BOURG -** Has disqualification issues but did run well when third in Class E at this track over 2175m on 21 December. Has a winning chance

**3. LOZEN DE BANVILLE -** Yet to win a race but was not disgraced when 5th in Class E over this course and distance on 4 January. Might play a minor role

**4. LA BOMBONERA -** Disqualified in her last three starts, with the latest being at this track on 6 January. Remains barefoot and is capable of improvement

**5. LUNA D'ARNHEM -** Yet to win a race and was 11th in Class D at this track over 2200m on 4 January. Needs major improvement to win

**6. L'ILE D'HAUFOR -** Unreliable but was victorious last time out in Class E at this track over 2850m on 25 December. Drops in distance but could follow up

**7. LA JOIE DE VIVRE -** Disqualified in her last three starts, with the latest being at Bernay on 28 July. Likely to need this run returning from a break

**8. LITTLE STAR JIEL -** Holding form and was third in Class E over this track and trip on 4 January. Clearly not out of it

**9. LICORNE QUICK -** Disappointing form of late and was 7th in Class E over this course and distance on 4 January. Others make more appeal

**10. L'ACCLAMATION -** Holding form and was a winner last time out in Class E at Argentan over 2800m on 26 December. Probably better that longer distance but can earn some money

**11. LOVE PROFUSION -** Did not show her best when 9th in Class E over this track and trip on 4 January. May be better over further but is capable of popping up in a place

**12. LORENE D'AVEZE -** Returned to form with a Class E win at this track over 2850m on 22 March. Has ability and is just as good this distance. Can score returning from a break

**13. LISA MONA BLUE -** Only fair of late and was 5th in Class E at this track over 2700m on 6 December. More is needed to beat these rivals

**Summary:** LORENE D'AVEZE (12) has been off the track since March but she runs unshod on all four and therefore she must be fit enough to play a leading role. Main dangers include the inform L'ILE D'HAUFOR (6) and LOUBIANA DU BOURG (2) who always goes close when she keep her stride in check. LITTLE STAR JIEL (8) is very competitive in this class of event and warrants some consideration.

**2. KARA DU PLESSIS -** Has some fair recent form and was 5th in Class E over this course and distance on 3 January. More is needed to beat these rivals

**3. KITTY PIYA -** On a long losing run but was barefoot and runner-up in a Class E over this track and trip on 3 January. Can get involved with the finish again

**4. KALINE DU PONCHET** - Yet to win a race but has been very consistent of late and was runner-up in Class E at this track over 2175m on 7 January. Not out of it

**5. KISS ME JIHEM -** On a very long losing run but was third last time out in a Class E Mounted race over this track and trip on 29 December. Better under the saddle but might play a minor role

**6. KIARHA DE NAPPES -** Only modest of late and was 7th in Class F at Cabourg over 2750m on 2 January. Needs to find a few lengths to win

**7. KIARA DES MONTS -** Yet to win but was not disgraced when fourth in Class E over this course and distance on 3 January. Might play a minor role

**8. KALIFA MESLOISE -** Showed improvement when 5th in Class E at Cabourg over 2750m on 2 January. Barefoot and could be the surprise package of the race

**9. KYA D'ERABLE -** Holding form and was fourth in Class E at this track over 2850m on 10 December. Not out of it this distance

**10. KATANE DU CORTA -** In good form and was third in Class E over this track and trip on 3 January. Has a winning chance

**11. KOREA -** Reminded us what she is capable of with her Class E win over this course and distance on 8 December. Can double up

**12. KALIE PRIMO** - In good form of late and was runner-up in Class F at Saint-Breuc over 3150m on 6 December. Disqualified when last seen at this track but could earn some minor money

**13. KWALITA SUPREME -** Showed improvement when barefoot and third in Class E at this track over 2175m on 13 December. Remains unshod and can contest the finish

**Summary:** An impressive winner over this course & distance one month ago, KOREA (11) is expected to confirm and follow up with another success. KWALITA SUPREME (13) is clearly on the rise after a lengthy break and could pose a threat. KYA D'ERABLE (9) finished in front of the selection two starts ago and has every chance on the back of this performance. KITTY PIYA (3) posted a reassuring effort last time out and cannot be ruled out of the equation.

**3. KINASSE DE VIVOIN -** Has struggled of late and was tenth in Class C at this track over 2700m on 11 December. Others are preferred

**4. KANELLE DE TILLARD -** Disqualified last time out at this track on 31 December. Distance suited and can be competitive if smart this time

**5. KIMIKO DU DOUBS -** Showed vast improvement when barefoot and third in Class D at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2550m on 27 December. Not fully barefoot this time and others are preferred

**6. KOSY D'ERONVILLE** - Has struggled with disqualifications of late and was disqualified last time out at this track on 5 December. Capable of playing a minor role when wise

7. KALICIA JOSSELYN - Disqualified last time out at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat on 27 December. Hard to trust and others are preferred

**8. KAY LEE DU CAMPUS** - Has struggled with disqualifications of late and faulted at this track on 31 December. Capable of earning minor money when smart

**9. KISS ME WINNER -** Did not show her best when 7th last time out in Class D at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2550m on 27 December. Better this distance and can make the frame

**10. KALINE DE FAEL** - At the top of her game and was runner-up last time out in Class D over this track and trip on 6 December. Big chance

**11. KAGUYA JIEL** - Disqualified last time out at this course on 30 August. Likely to need this run returning from a break

**12. KARAIELLA BOND** - Unreliable but was runner-up last time out in Class D at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2550m on 27 December. Could make the frame

**13. KELLE HAUFOR** - Unreliable and was tenth in Class C at this track over 2700m on 31 December. Has won over this course and distance and can contest the finish

**14. KARVINA D'ELA** - Disqualified in three of her last four starts including last time out at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat on 27 December. Capable of a surprise if wise

**15. KOUSINE CARISAIE** - In good form and was third in Class E at Pontchâteau over 2800m on 22 December. Better over further and others are preferred

**16. KALINDA DU PARC -** On a very long losing run since only win but was not disgraced when 5th in Class D at Vincennes over 2175m on 14 December. Has a place chance

**Summary:** KALINE DE FAEL (10) is not ideally draw on the second tier but she boasts a very good record when racing barefoot and is selected to resume winning ways. A winner of her only previous outing over today's course & distance, KELLE HAUFOR (13) is another one with a leading chance. Reunited with Franck Nivard, KELLE CLASS (2) can bounce back to form and score. KANELLE DE TILLARD (4) usually performs well under this shoeing feature and is another one for the shortlist.
