- **10. HAWAI PONT VAUTIER -** Finished a place behind HERALDIQUE (15) at Meslay-du-Maine before coming 2nd in a 2950m Toulouse Class D mid-January and is very hard to ignore
- 11. HASARD D'ERABLE Modest 5th in a 2100m Vincennes Class D on 25 January. Unbeaten at Vire but is shod for return to the venue and best to wait
- **12. HAITIAN FIGHT SONG -** Runner-up in a 2850m Laval Class D a fortnight ago after having won at Angers. Shoes back on but is still capable of winning a race of this nature
- 13. HIPPOMENE QUESNOT Lost his action in a 2850m Laval Class D 2 weeks ago but is no slouch when focused and, with application, can make the first 5
- **14. EXPEDITIOUS -** Makes first start since August 2023 when last of 14 in a 2725m Gr.3 at Grenade-sur-Garonne, and will need the run
- **15. HERALDIQUE -** Unraced since trotting 2nd in a 2600m Meslay-du-Maine Class D on 21 December but is seldom out of the first 2 and is not about to let the side down
- **16. GLOIRE DES LOYAUX -** Failed to confirm her Nantes performance when 10th of 15 in the Laval race of reference, but is seldom far from the action and can redeem herself
- 17. FINOU DU LUOT Complicated trotter that was sanctioned on re-entry in the race of reference and has no realistic chance

Summary: Back at the top of her game since the turn of the year, HAITIAN FIGHT SONG (12) should find the Vire profile to her liking and looks a marginally better bet than the ever-consistent HERALDIQUE (15) who has not been seen out for over two months. HAWAI PONT VAUTIER (10) boasts a similar profile and his Toulouse performance bodes well for his prospects. Given an easy freshener at Châteaubriant, GAROU LIONNAIS (4) will be barefoot this time and the 25m head-start will do his chances no disservice.
